SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES



PURPOSE:

To survey and monument Lot 15 of Timber Line Subdivision, described within Document No. 2017-033724 of the Official Records in Jackson County, Oregon. Narrative is a separate document from the Map of Survey

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Leica GS-16 GNSS receiver and Leica TS-16i robotic total station with ranging prisms, I survey and monument the lands as shown. Timber Line Subdivision was recorded on July 28, 1964 in Volume 9, Page 45 of the Plat Records in Jackson County, Oregon. Many errors exist on that subdivision plat, the most noticeable in this area being the right of way of Pinecrest Terrace varies from 45' to 41', when plat record says it should be 47'. Iron pipe monuments recovered in this subdivision, typical of the type used by L.E. Ager, fit neither side of the right of way very well. Block 6 has been largely resolved by Everett L. Swain on Surveys 7452 and 8787, while portions of Block 5 have also been resolved by Swain on Surveys 4030 and 4349, but none of those surveys addressed the width of the right of way of Pinecrest Terrace between each block. Monuments recovered on Block 6 from the original subdivision and from Swain's surveys fit well with Swain's resolution and the centerline monument at Walker Avenue and Peachey Road, with the exception of the iron pipe monument recovered at the northwest corner of Lot 4, which seems to be offset in the opposite direction as indicated on Survey No. 7452. Holding the resulting south right of way line of Pinecrest Terrace and off-setting this line 47 feet fit the monuments found on the north right of way within a few tenths, although the lead & tack witness corner set by Swain at the southeast corner of Lot 14 seems to be a 0.50' witness corner in the opposite direction as shown on Survey No. 4030. Monuments recovered at the corners of the subject property fit well with plat record and were The southeast corner of the subject tract was determined by proportioning the found distance between found monuments on either side against plat record for the arc distances. Utility boxes located at the corner location resulted in a 2.00' witness corner being set.



BASIS OF BEARING: The Basis of Bearing for this survey is the centerline of Walker Avenue

from Peachey Road to Siskiyou Boulevard, having a record bearing of North 00°06'55" West, as referenced on Survey No. 23292, on file in the

office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
