

LOCATION:

Located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To document the location of monuments set on the perimeter boundary of a proposed Property Line Adjustment not yet executed. The application for the Property Line Adjustment was conditionally approved by the City of Ashland Department of Community Development, Planning Division, on June 23, 2022 as File No. PA-A-2022-00206. The original Property Line Adjustment has been converted to a Map of Survey to ensure compliance with O.R.S. 209.250 (4)(b). This Map of Survey is not a Land Division or Property Line Adjustment


BASIS OF BEARINGS:

The Basis of Bearings was determined by high presicion GPS observations (NAD83(2011) Epoch 2010.00 Datum) applied to the West line of Donation Land Claim No. 39, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, City of Ashland, Oregon, resulting in a bearing of N00°04'25"W.

PROCEDURE:

Using a Trimble S6 Total Station and Trimble R-10 GPS receivers, I recovered and tied the existing monuments of record as shown herein. The subject property is contained within the Highland Park Tract and portions were surveyed by Everett Swain and George Burrell in the 1970's and 1980's. As first described in the narrative of Survey Number (S/N) 5850, and subsequently held on following surveys (said surveys refer to the subdivision as the Highland Park Addition, not the Highland Park Tract), the West line of Donation Land Claim (DLC) No. 39 was held as the West line of said Highland Park Tract. The existing centerline monument at the intersection of Meade and Pearl Street was found to be 0.90' (0.84' on this survey) easterly of said West DLC line. To hold the intent of the original subdivision, the lots were proportioned between the West line of DLC No. 39 and the centerline of Gresham Street. The existing centerline monuments along Meade Street were then used to determine the position of the lot corners along the right-of-way of Meade Street. The 3/4" pipe at the intersection of Meade and Summit Street created an angle break along Meade Street as shown on S/N 5850 and multiple surveys in the area. I was unable to recover said pipe and thus hold recovered monuments and record data as shown herein for said position. It should be noted that the bearing along Meade Street from the SW Corner of DLC No. 39 to the 3/4" pipe at the intersection of Meade and Summit Street as shown on S/N 5850 was in error by 00°01' as discovered on S/N 12869. This caused the recovered corners as set on S/N's 5850, 10654, and 12869 along Meade Street to vary a minuscule distance from their computed positions. The centerline of Gresham Street was established by holding the recovered centerline monuments at the intersections of Gresham and Pearl Street, and Gresham and Auburn Streets and extending said centerline south to intersect the centerline of Iowa Street. The right-of-way width for Gresham Street on the Highland Park Tract is shown as being 60', S/N 6648 and 6991 show it being 35' from a centerline holding the existing monuments along Gresham Street. S/N 6991 also visually shows the monument at the intersection of Gresham and Iowa Street as not being at the intersection of aforementioned south extension thereof.
