

Written narrative to accompany plat for Survey No. 2391

Survey for De. Ralph Thompson, 18 N. Modoc Ave. Medford, Oregon.

Completed December 14, 1963. Bearings from Survey NO. 1784

Located in the West 1/2 of Section 34, and in D.L.C. 57,
Township 37 Soutn, Range 1 West, Jackson County, Oregon.

From the 2" iron pipe at the Southeast corner of DLC NO. 57, we
chained a line to the 2" pipe at the Southwest corner of DLC 57,
making ties to all property corners along the north line of Coal
Mine Road.

Then from the 1/4 Section Corher on the north line of Section
34, a 1" pipe with 10" exposure we find a 5/8" bar N $89^{\circ}47'40''W$
a distance of 62.90 feet, also a 1" pipe with 8" exposure that is
0.22 North and 0.12 West from the bar

We then ran a tie line from the above bar to a 5/8" bar set on
the north line of Coal Mine Road, said bar being N $89^{\circ}50'15''W$
1213.15 feet and N $0^{\circ}15'50''E$ from the Southeast corner of D.L.C.
No. 57. Also at this location we find a 3/4" pipe at 19.00 feet
from the DLC line, but on the true property line north and south.

We next made ties to the to the 5/8" bar at the northeast
corner of the Dr. Drummond property (set in survey No 692)
and ran a line to check the nail in concrete that we had previously
set at the time the bar was removed to place the fence, as shown
on the map.

With the above controls we set 5/8" bars 5/8" x 24" and 5/8"x
30" at points as shown on the plat. All bars were driven to
plus or minus 2" from Ground surface, and 30" guard stakes with
flagging was placed at each.
