SURVEY NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AS A RESULT OF THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S JACKSON AND JOSEPHINE COUNTY CURB RAMPS, PHASE 3 PROJECT. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO RECORD THE POSITIONS OF MONUMENTS OF RECORD. RESOLVE THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY (R/W) CENTERLINES, AND DEFINE THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY LINES AS DIRECTED IN OREGON REVISED STATUTE (ORS)209.155. ADDITIONALLY, THIS SURVEY IS BEING FILED DUE TO CORRECT AN ISSUE CREATED BY COUNTY SURVEY NUMBERS 21075 AND 22564 (BOTH ON FILE WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE). THE INITIAL RETRACEMENT MAP (SAID NO. 21075) DID NOT CORRECTLY RETRACE HIGHWAY 99 IN THE AREA SHOWN HEREON. THIS LED TO MONUMENTS BEING SET AS REPRESENTING THE RIGHT OF WAY ON SAID SURVEY 22564, WHICH IN FACT FELL APPROXIMATELY 2 FEET OFF OF THE RIGHT OF WAY. POINT NUMBER 5001-5003 WERE SET HEREON TO CORRECT THIS ISSUE.

"RVH" CENTERLINE

THE "RVH" CENTERLINE SHOWN HEREON WAS RESOLVED UTILIZING SAID MAP OF SURVEY NO 22564, ON FILE AT THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE. THE RECORD ALIGNMENT AND RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN CONTROL POINTS 1272331 AND 1272327 WAS CALCULATED. THIS LINEWORK WAS THEN TRANSLATED TO POINT 1272331 AND ROTATED TO POINT 1272327. THE RECORD DISTANCE FIT WITHIN 0.06', THE "RVH" ALIGNMENT WAS THEN HELD PER SAID SURVEY 22564 AND SHOWN HEREON TO ESTABLISH THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RECORD ALIGNMENT WHICH CONTROLLED A PORTION OF HIGHWAY 99 AND THE NEWLY CREATED "MN" CENTERLINE WHICH IS BASED ON THE OLD CITY OF PHOENIX BLOCK LINES THAT CONTROLLED A PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY (SEE BELOW).

"MN" CENTERLINE

THE "MN" CENTERLINE IS CREATED HEREON TO RETRACE THE ORIGINAL BLOCK LINES, AND ALSO IN THE EVENT ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY NEEDED TO BE PURCHASED FOR THIS PROJECT. ACQUISITION DOCUMENTS SHOWN ON ODOT DRAWING 7B-10-13 WERE UTILIZED IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH THE CORRECT RIGHT OF WAY WIDTHS AS SHOWN. POINTS 1009 AND 1002 WERE HELD AT THEIR RECORD OFFSETS TO ESTABLISH THE TANGENT SHOWN HEREON AND STATIONING WAS ASSUMED.

WEST 6TH STREET

WHILE LOOKING FOR MONUMENTATION TO RESOLVE 6TH STREET, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE CITY OF PHOENIX HAD PERFORMED AN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN 2018 THAT HAD DESTROYED MONUMENTATION ALONG CHURCH STREET AND PARTICULARLY THE CENTERLINE MONUMENTS. THE CITY WAS NOTIFIED AS WELL AS THE ENGINEERING FIRM THAT CREATED THE PLAN SET. THERE WAS NO AGREED UPON PLAN MOVING FORWARD FOR EITHER PARTY TO REPLACE THESE MONUMENTS AS DIRECTED IN ORS 209.155. UPON REVIEW OF VARIOUS TIES TO THIS POINT AS SHOWN ON LOCAL SURVEYS, ALONG WITH ODOT ELECTRONIC FILES UTILIZED TO PERFORM SAID COUNTY SURVEY 21075, THE POSITION OF THIS MONUMENT WAS CENTERED AROUND THE PREVIOUS ODOT TIE BY ROUGHLY 0.03' DEPENDING ON WHICH MONUMENTS AND ROTATION WAS HELD. I HAVE UTILIZED THE PREVIOUS ODOT MEASUREMENT TO ESTABLISH THE CENTERLINE POINT (POINT 5000 HEREON) AND THE RECORD OFFSET OF 1003 IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH W 6TH ST. I HAVE NOTIFIED THE CITY OF THIS POINT BEING REPLACED AND AM UNSURE OF THEIR PLANS TO REPLACE THE REMAINING MONUMENTATION DESTROYED BY THEIR 2018 PROJECT. THERE WAS ALSO A STREET VACATION OF 10' ON BOTH SIDES OF 6TH ST., FILED UNDER VOLUME 317 PAGE 414 OF THE JACKSON COUNTY RECORDER'S RECORDS, WHICH WAS UTILIZED TO ESTABLISH A WIDTH OF 40 FEET (20 FEET EACH SIDE OF CENTERLINE).

WEST 5TH STREET

WEST 5TH ST. WAS RESOLVED BY UTILIZING FOUND MONUMENTATION SHOWN HEREON, AND RIGHT OF WAY WIDTHS PER THE PLAT OF PHOENIX. IT WAS NECESSARY TO RESOLVE 5TH STREET IN ORDER TO HELP ESTABLISH THE TAPER ON THE WEST SIDE OF N. MAIN ST. WHICH WENT FROM THE SOUTHEAST BLOCK CORNER OF BLOCK 5, PLAT OF PHEONIX, TO THE NORTH LINE OF SAID

CONTROL NARRATIVE AND BASIS OF BEARING

ALL BEARINGS ARE BASED ON THE OREGON COORDINATE REFERENCE SYSTEM (OCRS) GRANTS PASS - ASHLAND ZONE, NAD 83(2011) EPOCH 2010.00. ALL COORDINATES ARE IN INTERNATIONAL FEET UNITS. SURVEY WORK FOR THIS PROJECT WAS PERFORMED BY ODOT SURVEY CREWS DURING AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER OF 2023. THIS SURVEY UTILIZED A LEICA GS18 GNSS RECEIVER, LEICA TS15 TOTAL STATION, AND LEICA CS20 DATA COLLECTOR. CONTROL SHOWN HEREON WAS INITIALLY SET ON SAID SURVEY NO. 22564. THE CONTROL VALUES WERE ESTABLISHED BY UTILIZING THE OREGON REAL TIME GEODETIC NETWORK (ORGN) AND OBSERVING 2 REDUNDANT 60 EPOCH OBSERVATIONS ON EACH CONTROL POINT. THESE OBSERVATIONS WERE A MINIMUM OF 30 MINUTES APART IN ACCORDANCE WITH ODOT'S POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL. FOUND MONUMENTATION SHOWN HEREON WAS MEASURED UTILIZING THE SAME METHOD STATED ABOVE. IN THE EVENT THE SKY WAS OBSTRUCTED AND A MONUMENT COULD NOT BE MEASURED FROM THE SHOWN CONTROL, ADDITIONAL CONTROL POINTS WERE SET, OR FOUND MONUMENTATION WAS UTILIZED AS CONTROL AND A TOTAL STATION WAS UTILIZED TO TIE THE POINT.

CONTROL POINTS FOR THIS SURVEY WERE NOT SET ON AND DO NOT REPRESENT PROPERTY OR RIGHT OF WAY LINES AND ARE INTENDED FOR THE USE BY ODOT IN SUPPORT OF THIS AND FUTURE PROJECTS. IT IS NOT THE INTENT OF ODOT TO PERPETUATE THESE CONTROL POINTS AS MONUMENTS.
