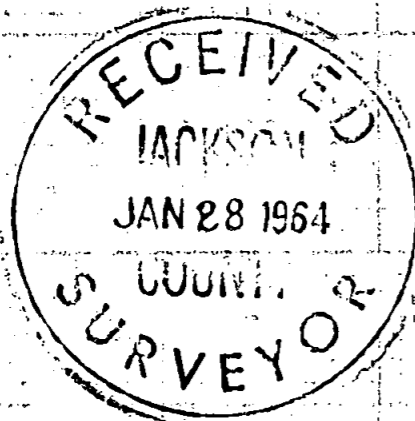

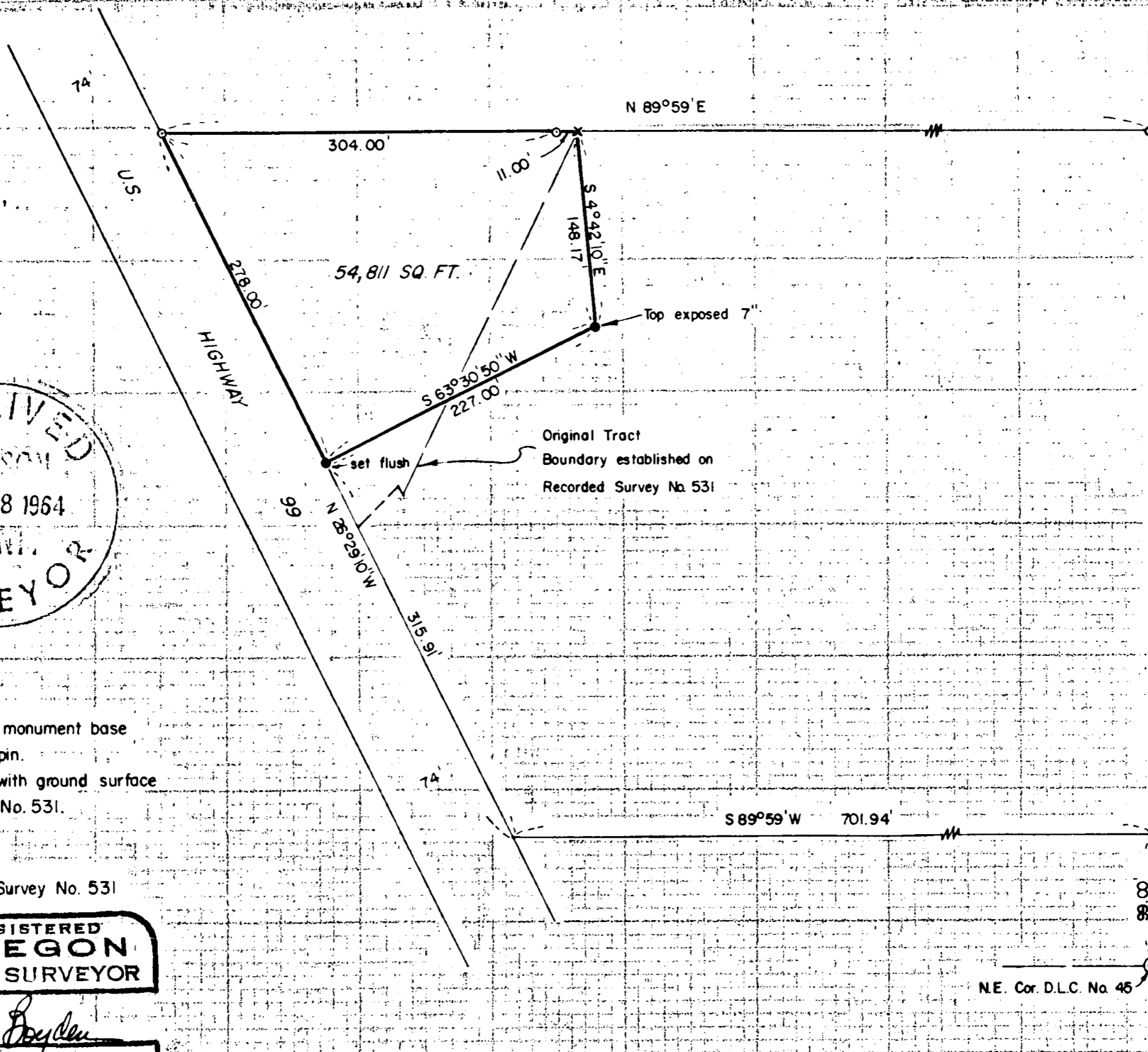
SCALE: 1" = 100'

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a parcel for lease purposes,
located in the Northwest corner of the overall
Bessonette leased tract.

PROCEDURE:

Found points previously set on Recorded Survey No. 531, for
control of the Highway and North property boundaries.

A portion of the existing concrete drainage tube was
uncovered, so that the Southeast corner of the surveyed parcel
would fall on the center of said drainage tube.
