

LOCATION:

Located within Section 35 and Section 36, Township 36 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

Pursuant to Client's request and direction, perform a Monument Recovery and Right-of-Way Retracement Survey within the extents of the project. The project extents involve the retracing of Wilson Road right-of-way, from Upton Road to Table Rock Road. This project also involves retracing the rights-of-way of the three intersecting streets: Upton Road, Gebhard Road, and Table Rock Road for approximately 100 feet. A monument recovery was performed to perpetuate the location of found monuments of record that may be removed, destroyed, or disturbed by future improvements to said roads.

SURVEY PROCEDURE:

Equipment and software utilized: Trimble TSC7 data collectors with Trimble Access Software; Trimble SX10 robotic and scanning instrument; Trimble S7 robotic instrument; Trimble R10 GNSS equipment; Trimble Business Center and Trimble Terramodel.

Linear unit (horizontal) is International Foot (ift); Linear unit (vertical) is U.S. Survey Foot (usft); Vertical datum is the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD88); Geodetic Information: Datum is the North American Datum (NAD) of 1983 (2011) Epoch 2010.00; System is the Oregon Coordinate Reference System; Zone is the Grants Pass-Ashland (refer to OAR 734). All bearings and distances shown hereon are projected (grid) values based on the projection definition herein and above. This projection was utilized in order to minimize the difference between projected (grid) distances and horizontal (ground) distances at the topographic surface within the design area of this coordinate system. The basis of bearings is Geodetic North. Note that the grid bearings depicted do not equal geodetic bearings due to meridian convergence.

Coordinate positions were obtained via GNSS measurements utilizing a fast static network tied into provided project control, from which base control was established and utilized for RTK methods, thence via classical terrestrial methods.

Established base control from said fast static network, thence primary control and ties to found monuments utilizing said R10, RTK methods and redundant ties. From which utilized terrestrial methods with a Trimble SX10 robotic and scanning instrument, Trimble S7 robotic instrument, and a Trimble TSC7 data collector with Access software to establish all remaining control and monument ties.

Field work and drafting performed between May 2023 and October 2023.

RIGHT-OF-WAY HISTORY & ANALYSIS FOR WILSON ROAD AND INTERSECTING STREETS:

UPTON ROAD:

The creation of the right-of-way for Upton Road was established in 1892 by Road Petition. Said creation was described in Commissioner's Journal Volume 9, Pages 349, 385-388, also transcribed as Road Record Volume 3, Page 40 of the Records of the Jackson County Road Department. The Commissioner's Journal describes the alignment of Upton Road as having a 40 feet width. The alignment abutted to and perpendicular to Wilson Road is described as following the easterly boundary line of Donation Land Claim No. 56 (John Rankin Claim 56). Upton Road, south of the Wilson Road Centerline, is 40 feet wide.

Upton Road, north of Wilson Road Centerline, was further dedicated as 60 feet in width beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 1 per the Plat of Roguelands Irrigated Orchards Tracts (recorded September 15, 1910 in Volume 2 at Page 46 of Book of Plats), thence northerly along the west boundary of said Lot 1. This alignment appears to follow the east line of Donation Land Claim No. 56. The southwest corner of

said Lot 1 has been re-established and accepted per Survey Number 2531, as a set 3/4-inch x 24 inches long iron pipe after an extensive search of the original monument. This dedication was affirmed per Volume 298, Page 143-144 of the Jackson County Deed Records and described beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot 1 "northerly to a point opposite the south line of Lot 9".

GEBHARD ROAD:

The creation of the right-of-way for Gebhard Road, southerly of Wilson Road intersection, was established in 1896 by Road Petition. Said creation was described in Commissioner's Journal Volume 10, Pages 548, 549, 561, 569-572, also transcribed as Road Record Volume 3, Page 124 of the Records of the Jackson County Road Department. Said Commissioner's Journal describes the width as being 40 feet. This alignment of Gebhard was further rectified during the subsequent "1910 Road Surveys" with 1/2-inch iron pipes. These pipes, verifying the alignment of Gebhard Road, south of Wilson Road, being within a portion of our project area, were subsequently located in Survey Numbers 2531, 10523 and 18573.

The creation of the right-of-way for Gebhard Road, northerly of Wilson Road, was established by I.L. Hamilton Et Ux, per deed recorded on March 23, 1911, as Volume 86, Page 474 of the Official Records of Jackson County. The width of Gebhard Road northerly of said intersection was established at 40 feet wide. The alignment for this road is along the "legal subdivision running North and South through the center of the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section 35". Survey Numbers 12732 and 22438 utilize this calculated alignment.

TABLE ROCK ROAD:

The right-of-way of Table Rock Road has been analyzed and determined by Survey Number 19245 and 22002. Said surveys go into detail describing alignment and widths. Record data for that portion of Table Rock Road, abutted to and perpendicular to Wilson Road, has been utilized on this survey.

WILSON ROAD:

Wilson Road - West of Gebhard Road

The creation of the right-of-way of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard, was created in two separate portions.

Westerly Portion Creation & Width

The westerly portion of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard Road, was created by dedication per the Plat of Roguelands Irrigated Orchard Tracts, filed on September 15, 1910, in Volume 2 at Page 46 of Book of Plats. The accepted southwest corner of Lot 1 per said Plat, is marked by a 3/4-inch x 24 inches long iron pipe set per Survey Number 2531. The alignment of said dedication follows along the southerly boundary of Lot 1 per said Plat and appears to follow the E-W centerline of Section 35, terminating westerly at the easterly line of Donation Land Claim 56. Said dedication width was 60 feet.

This portion of Wilson Road, along the southerly boundary of said Lot 1, was then vacated per Volume 298, Page 143-144 of the of the deed records of Jackson County (filed May 24, 1948) by court order. A subsequent court order, Commissioner's Journal Volume 60, Page 258, dated September 25, 1963, signed by County Judge, Earl M. Miller, declared Wilson Road a "through road", from the intersection of Table Rock, westerly to the intersection of Upton Road.

Easterly Portion Creation & Width

The easterly portion of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard Road, was created during the creation of Gebhard Road by said 1896 Road Petition. Said creation was described in Commissioner's Journal Volume 10, Pages 548, 549, 561, 569-572, also transcribed as Road Record Volume 3, Page 124 of the Records of the Jackson County Road Department. A portion of the alignment's description in said Road Record, describes "North 80 chains from place of beginning, being 1 mile, -set mile post... thence West 20 chains to stake from mile post... thence North 60 chains". The "thence West 20 chains" is the segment of Wilson Road, from the intersection of Gebhard Road and Wilson Road, westerly. Said road alignment was established at 40 feet wide per said journal at page 571.

Accepted Alignment

The accepted alignment of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard Road, begins at the 3/4 inch x 24 inches long iron pipe set per Survey Number 2531 and runs easterly to the Quarter Corner common to Sections 35 and 36. Subsequent surveys, including 12732, 22177, 22438, etc., have utilized this alignment.

Wilson Road - East of Gebhard Road

The creation of the right-of-way of Wilson Road, east of Gebhard Road, was granted through the following deeds from landowners to Jackson County during 1926:

Charles L. Wilson Et Ux, Volume 161, Page 463, recorded August 11, 1926

Will H. Wilson Et Al, Volume 161, Page 464, recorded August 11, 1926

Henry L. Gregory Et Ux, Volume 161, Page 465, recorded August 11, 1926

C. J. Mccay Et Al, Volume 161, Page 466, recorded August 11, 1926

A.P. Weiss Et Ux, Volume 161, Page 467, recorded August 11, 1926

Lucinda Weeden, Volume 162, Page 59, recorded September 11, 1926

Collectively, these deeds describe a 60 feet wide strip of land, aligned along the East-West Center Section line, beginning at a point 1320 feet west of the Quarter corner common to Sections 35 and 36, heading easterly to the center of Section 36.

RIGHT-OF-WAY DETERMINATION FOR WILSON ROAD AND INTERSECTING STREETS:

UPTON ROAD:

It has been determined that the centerline of Upton Road follows the east line of Donation Land Claim 56 at a 40 feet width southerly of the intersection of Upton Road and Wilson Road. Northerly of said intersection, the width of Upton Road is 60 feet.

GEBHARD ROAD:

It has been determined that the centerline of Gebhard Road, south of Wilson Road, is aligned by the 1910 monuments set per "1910 Road Surveys" and verified by Survey Number 10523 and 18573. The width is 40 feet within our project area.

The portion of Gebhard Road, northerly of its intersection with Wilson Road, is aligned by the "line of legal subdivision running North and South through the center of the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section 35" per said Volume 86, Page 474. This alignment is calculated per Survey Numbers 12732 and 22438 using record distances and angles. This portion of Gebhard Road is 40 feet wide.

The alignment of Gebhard Road, northerly and southerly of its intersection with Wilson Road, is not continuous. This alignment is offset.

TABLE ROCK ROAD:

As stated herein above, the right-of-way of Table Rock Road has been analyzed and determined by Survey Number 19245 and 22002. Said surveys go into detail describing alignment and widths. Record data from Survey Number 22002 has been utilized for that portion of Table Rock Road, abutted to and perpendicular to Wilson Road.

WILSON ROAD:

Wilson Road - West of Gebhard Road

Westerly Portion Determination

The westerly portion of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard Road, is aligned from the accepted southwest corner of RIOT Lot 1, easterly, along the line to the Quarter Corner common to Section 35 and 36, for 1161.9 feet at 60 feet wide. This westerly portion has been vacated per said Volume 298, Page 143-144.

Easterly Portion Determination

The easterly portion of Wilson Road, west of Gebhard Road, has been determined to align from the 1/2-inch iron pipe found per "1910 Road Survey" at the intersection of Wilson Road and Gebhard Road, westerly along the line to the southwest corner of said RIOT Lot 1 for 20 chains (1320 feet). This is 40 feet wide.

Wilson Road - East of Gebhard Road

The right-of-way of Wilson Road, east of Gebhard Road, is aligned to the East-West Center Section line at 60 feet wide.
