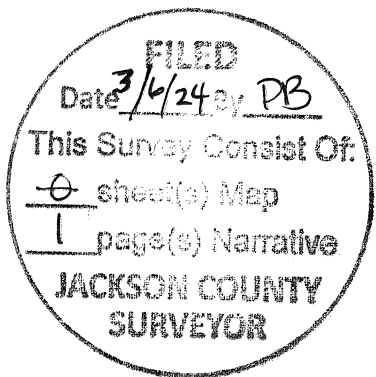

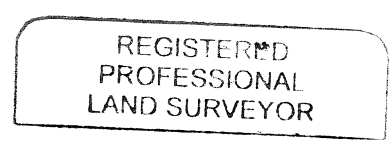
All of the monuments shown as "Deferred Monument" have been established with a 5/8 inch by 24 inch iron rebar with plastic cap marked "HOFFBUHR AND ASSOC., INC." *EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:*

A Lead plug with tack and metal washer marked "L.S. 2023" was set at the ell corner on the north line of Lot 4 being North 00°04'02" West 13.32 feet from the southwest corner of Lot 3.

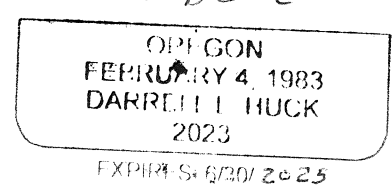
In addition, 6 inch Mag spikes with metal washers marked "L.S. 2023" were set at the southwest corner of Lot 3 and at the Northwest corner and the Southeast corners of Lot 5, and at the Northwest corner of Lot 6.

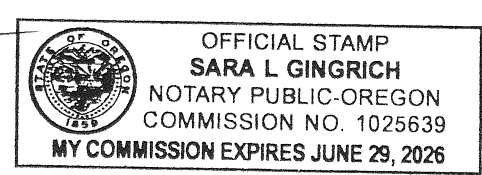
