

Survey Narrative to comply with O.R.S. 209-250:

Survey for: City of Jacksonville

LOCATION: City of Jacksonville, in the Northwest corner of Section 32 Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM.

BASIS OF BEARING: Survey No. 1339

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

At the request of the City of Jacksonville, surveyed and monumented Oregon Street.

This was done, taking into consideration the following evidence:

- 1. The plat of the City of Jacksonville and ties along Oregon St. to the Section line.
- 2. Existing older fence lines which have been recognized as property lines along the westerly side of Oregon St. and Blk. 26, 29 & 53.
- 3. 2 iron pins and 3 iron pipes found close to the westerly line of Oregon Street.
 - 4. Record bearing in road petition and deed records.

From this survey found that in Blk. 56 the fence line bears westerly approx. 1.0 feet and 2.0 to 3.0 feet in the center of Blk. 60 (note; this Blk. survey was made by Ager, approx. in 1945 for Hartman)

A large portion along the easterly side of Oregon St. near the southerly end is now fenced by adjacent owners.

Made a search on older deed recitals, found calls of property to the easterly line of Oregon St., but later deed calls, holding distance, would over-lap in Oregon St.

Made a search on possible vacation and found none.

The un-recorded survey by L. Ager in block 60 shows and angle point in Oregon St., also Blk. 60 being in excess of 55 feet longer than the plat indicates, also that the section line as shown by Ager, varies considerable further west. His survey does not show the tie to Section corner north or south.

Agers map would be in considerable conflict with this survey, survey No. 1673, City of Jacksonville plat, and old deeds and monuments.

Improvements on Lot 3 Blk. 29 and Lot 1, Blk. 30 extend approx. 7.5 ft. into Pine St., also frontage as occupied extended the same, also the conflict in deed recital from metes and bounds in said deed holding distance are in conflict with the plat about approx, the same amount.

The following monuments were set:

At Oregon at Pine St., set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pin, 6 in.

At Oregon St. at Fir St., set a 3/4 in. x 30 in. iron pin, 6 in.

At the end of Oregon St., set 2 iron pins 5/8 in. x 30 in. 6 in.

On the center line of a 1909 road location, S. 89°42'30"W., 24.35 ft. (record West 24.00) set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pin in a sand stone being a 1909 road point, 6 ins. deep. MAR-11 1954

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
