

Survey narrative to comply with Oregon Revised Statutes 209.120 and
209.250

Purpose of survey:

To locate and monument the west and south
line of the tract shown

Equipment of survey:

Standardized 100 and 300 foot steel tapes
and six second optical transit

Procedure of survey:

Raised section line control as shown and held deed record
deflection angles and distances.

Due to change in plans, the client did not desire additional
work performed to determine definite road control on the north line
of the premises. Accordingly, the road as shown is approximate.

However, as both the SE corner of Section 20 and the SW corner
of D.L.C. 48 were closed upon during the 1910 road traverse, a
correlation was established with this survey suggesting that County
road bearings should be reduced 3'10" West of North as shown.

On this basis, County road station coordinates as adjusted
check with this survey against record by 0.17 feet in latitude and
0.23 feet in departure and constitute probable angle point locations
where subsequent P.I. control search might be made.
