PROCEDURE:

Found monuments set on EAGLE PARK SUBDIVISION (recorded) and on Recorded Survey No. 1595, to control the North boundary of DLC #46 and the Southeasterly boundary of Platt Avenue.


The centerline location of the Medford Corporation Railroad right-of-way was determined by using the railroad tangent previously established by EAGLE PARK SUBDIVISION; the official railroad survey curve data of ($\Delta = 23^{\circ} 50^{\circ}$; $D = 6^{\circ} 00^{\circ}$) and a mean average of existing tie centers.

Portions of Platt Avenue and Fargo, Grady and Haley Streets were vacated by the City of Eagle Point (see Volume 563, Page 368 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon)

That portion of the Dodenhoff ownership lying Northeasterly from Lot 1, Block 1 of D & D SUBDIVISION is proposed to be. conveyed to Hostutler, the adjacent owner.
