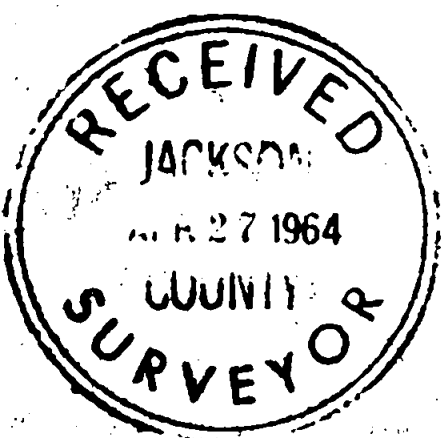
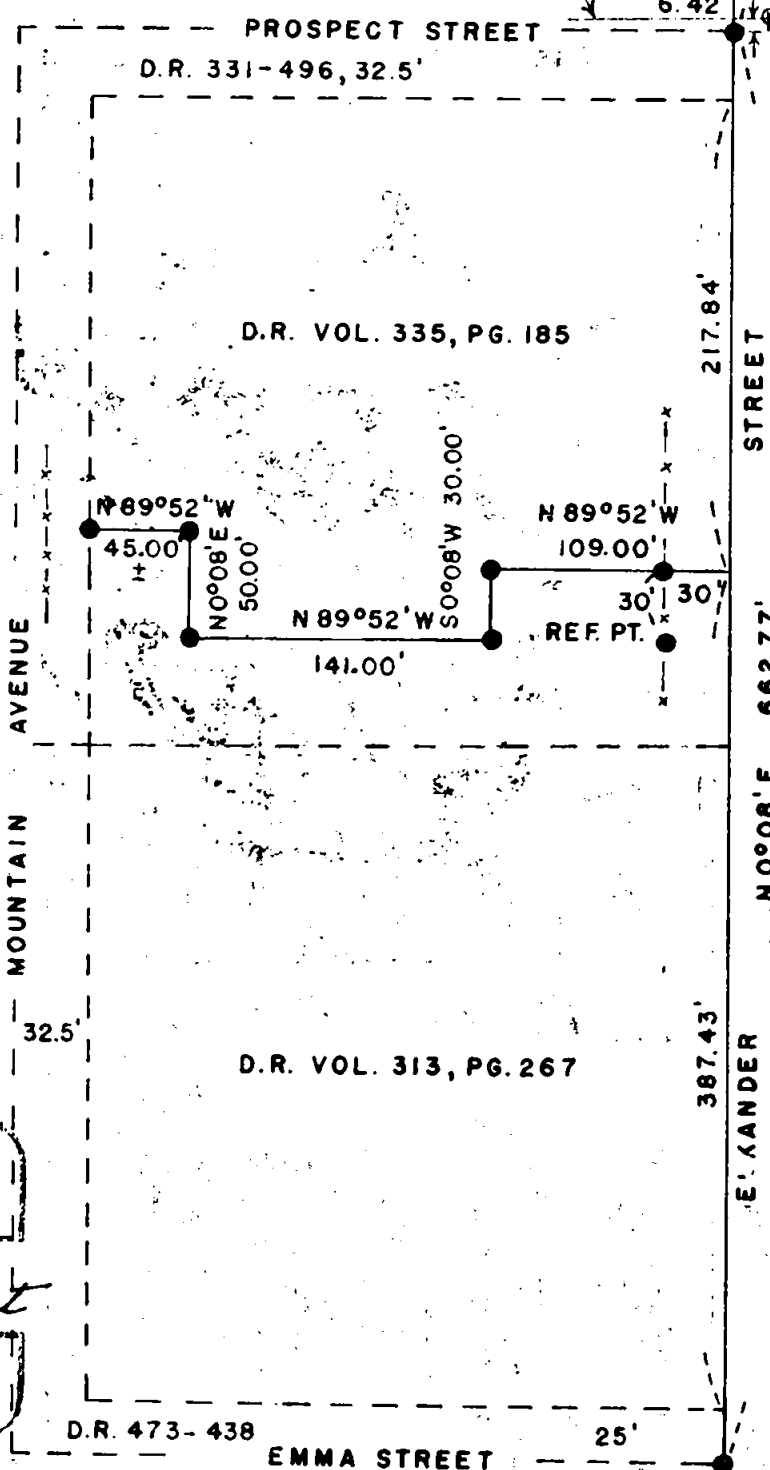


FD. SEC. COR. 1" SQ. IRON BAR

Purpose : To determine the east boundary of the tracts
 shown and monument a separation line.

Procedure : Commenced at the one-quarter corner and ran
 North on random line recovering NE corner of
 Section 16 per information Galey Addition.
 Set corners shown from coordinates.

Limitation of economics did not permit the
 establishment of the NW, SW corners which
 would have involved subdivision of Section
 16.

Westerly pin set is approximate with respect
 to the east boundary of Mountain Avenue.

General : Basis of bearing: Solar observation

From pipe at $\frac{1}{4}$ corner: 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " stand pipe bears
 N $90^{\circ}34'10''$ W 96.46'

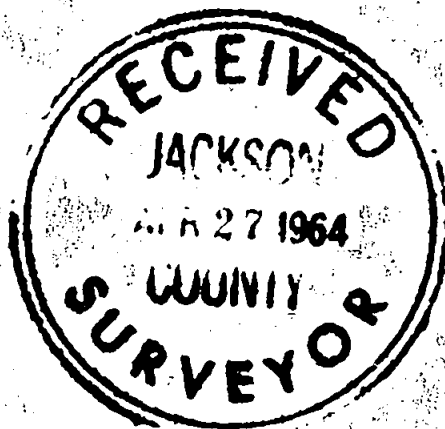
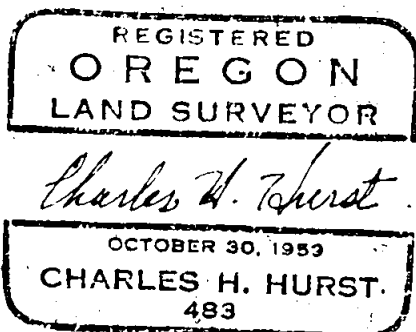
Valve of top of fire hyd.
 bears N $30^{\circ}09'56''$ W 38.35'

21.3" W.O. with faces
 chopped out, scribe indistinct
 on top face, chaining notch
 visible bears N $76^{\circ}56'10''$ W
 17.50 feet (to butt face)

$\frac{3}{4}$ " pipe bears N $82^{\circ}20'10''$ W
 39.65 feet (located at W edge
 of 6" RCP)

March 23, 1964

Note: Ager states he set pipe at $\frac{1}{4}$ corner during
 the 1940's on basis of 2 bearing trees. NE
 BT now missing.
