PURPOSE OF SURVEY: To survey and furnish descriptions of the two parcels as shown and set the required monuments.

LOCATION OF SURVEY: Tracts being located in Donation Land Claim No. 39 and the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, Township 37 South of Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

SURVEY PROCEDURE: Bearings for the survey were derived from Recorded Survey No. 2153. The field control established by the afore-mentioned survey was also used for this survey. The Southeast Corner of the tract described in said survey No. 2153 was located, being a $1\frac{1}{2}$ galvanized pipe, the Northeast Corner was also found, being a $1\frac{1}{4}$ iron pin, these corners were used to establish the West line of the tract being surveyed. Previously established control was used to establish the southerly line of the Crater Lake Highway (O.S.H.D. No. 62). Property corners were set and monumented as indicated on the attached map.
