With the exception of the northerly 10 feet, this survey was previously surveyed by Mr. L. Ager in 1946 (prior to recording date) for Mr. Shaffer, who engaged Mr. Ager to make a survey for segregation, therefore monuments found on this survey were held to determine the intent.

The monuments found:

- 2. 1/2 in. iron pipe sur. No. 114.
- 3. 5/8 in. iron pin by L. Lovejoy, on an unrecorded survey.
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- 5. 1/2 in. iron pipe or pin approx. 2 ft. deep by Ager, this pipe approx. 30 ins. above the surface
- 6. Pipe near corner unknown to me or its origin
- 7. 3/4 in. pipe by L. Ager
- 8. 1 in. pipe by L. Ager
