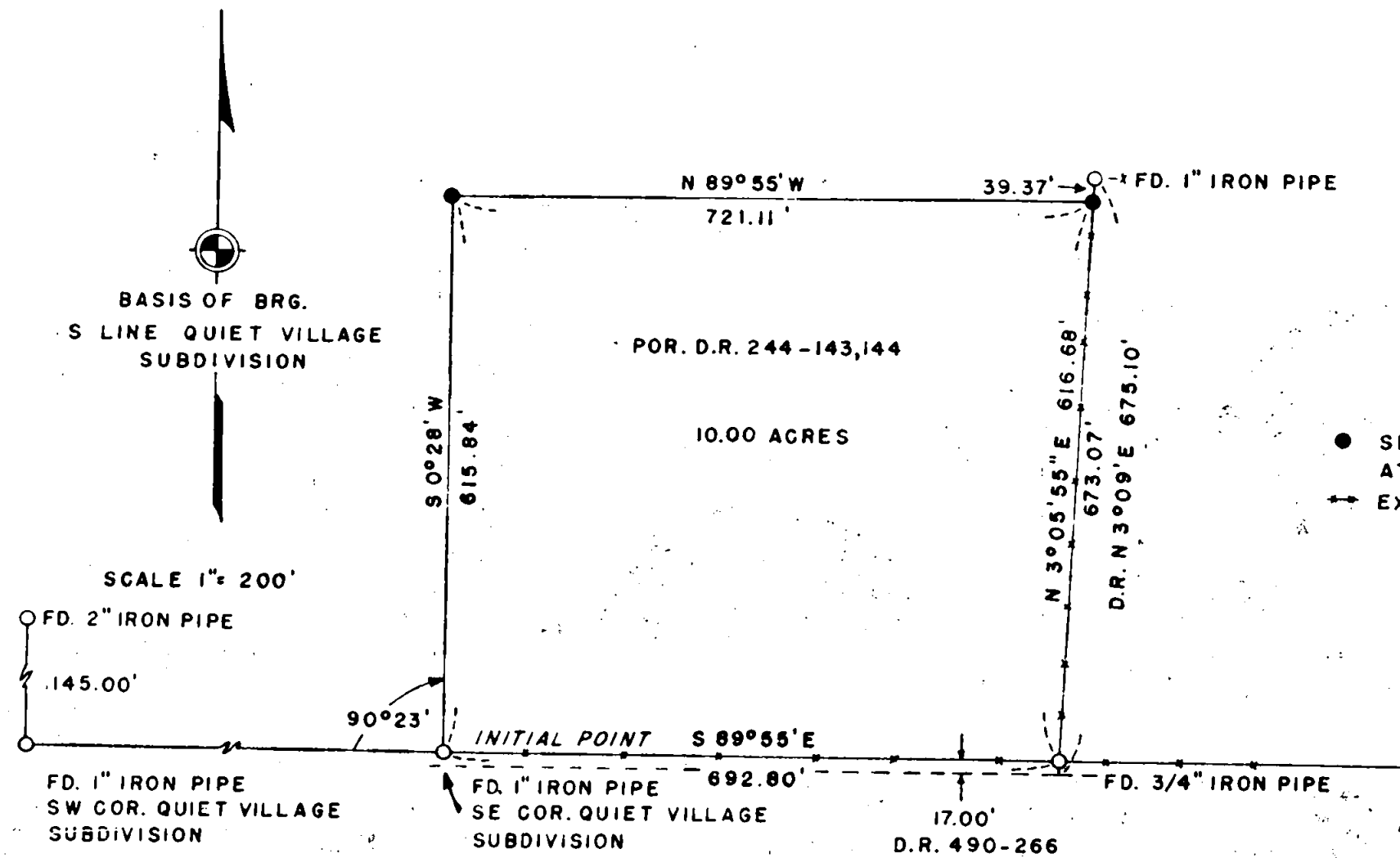

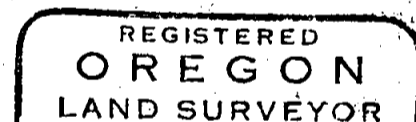
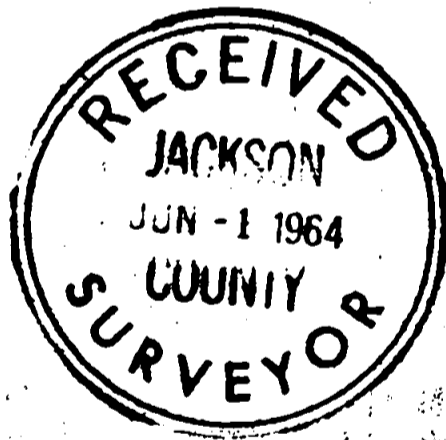
Basis of bearing: Record for Quiet Village Subdivision

Purpose of survey: To separate and define the boundary of the tract of land shown, said tract to contain 10 acres.

Procedure of survey:

Raised line of sight along the north line of Nevada Street projecting same East closing on a 3/4" pipe said by Mr. Fowler to have been set to define the west boundary of that tract of land described in DR 427-59 at the time said parcel was first conveyed. Per client's wishes, said line was held together with the projection of the east boundary of Quiet Village North.
