To define the north and west boundary of the tract

Procedure

In terms of the objectives stated above, raised the 3/4" pipe monuments reported to have been set by one Hurd who was retained by School District 9 to survey the property described in D.R. 420-233. The pipes monumenting the south boundary of Tract C were removed during the course of fence construction. According to Mr. Boren and School Superintendent Hale, this fence constitutes the agreement line between both parties concerned.

Deed record angle was turned from the 3/4" pipe monuments found in accordance with the afcrementioned deed which is written so as to indicate that the projection of the south line of Tract A easterly should coincide with the south boundary of Tract C. The difference in the projection easterly and the existing fence is shown on the attached plat.


The south boundary of the tract shown was determined by by turning deed record angle at the southeast corner thereof, said corner set deed record distance from the computed SE corner of DLC 45 subject to differences as indicated and in accordance with subordinate deed call. Further work to determine the original location of the county road in accordance with superior deed call was not undertaken per request of the client.

The east and west boundary of the tract surveyed was determined by projection of a line at right angles to the centerline of "B" Street from monuments previously established at 3rd. and 4th. Streets.

Ties to both the computed location of the DLC corner from the witness corner and the proposed location of the centerline of the county road are indicated since both are considered relative to this survey.

All monuments set are at ground level and this survey was completed May 4, 1964.
