

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: H.C. Witham

Fifth and Riverside Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe three parcels proposed to be purchased by Witham.

PROCEDURE:

Biddle Road centerline was established from the Jackson County Road retracement notes of 1947 and section line monuments found.

Hilton Road was established plat record distances Northerly from original monuments found along the South boundary of the subdivision and further verified by Recorded Survey No. 1415 monuments found.

Interstate Highway No. 5 was established from iron pins found along the Northeasterly right # of -way boundary.


Re-located Bullock Road and the Medco railroad right-of-way boundaries were established from monuments set by the Oregon State Highway survey crews.

The East boundary of Lot 8, Block 1, HILTON SUBDIVISION was established by proportionate measurement between the West and Southeasterly boundaries of the subdivision as shown.

The radius return at the Northwest intersection of Bullock Road and Hilton Road was established from the County Road Survey of 1928, as tied to the Southeast corner of DLC #38.

Set 5/8" x 30" iron pins for all new property corners as shown.
