


SCENIC HILLS MEMORIAL PARK



Ager, a duly registered Surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines. Beginning at a point on the North line of Donation Land Claim No. 48, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon, which point bears S. 89° 32' 45" W. 1493.89 feet from the Northeast corner of said Claim; thence S. 0° 00' 50" E. 518.96 feet; thence N. 86° 33' W. 545.65 feet; thence North 987.21 feet; thence East 682.0 feet; thence S. 0° 00' 50" E. 500.0 feet; thence S. 89° 32' 45" W. 137.59 feet to the point of beginning.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH ORS 209.250

FOR: C.C. Williams
707 Helman Street, &
Ashland, Oregon.

LOCATION: D. L. C. # 48 and Section 11, Township 39 South,
Range 1 East W.M., Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the boundaries of and
monument the centers of burial plots contained
within the boundaries of the SCENIC HILLS MEMORIAL
PARK, a cemetery subdivision.

PROCEDURE: From monuments found on the Easterly and Southerly
boundaries I surveyed and monumented the boundaries
of the portion of land contained within the Cemetery
Subdivision. For bearing control I used the record
bearings of the lines previously established and
monumented. Set 5/8 inch bar steel rods for the
NE, NW and SW corners of the Subdivision. Found
5/8 inch iron rods at the SE, East Ell and on the
East line of the subdivision. For the initial point
of survey indicated on the map, I placed a 2 inch
galvanized iron pipe over the 5/8 inch iron rod
found in place at this point. I set iron pipes at
the PC, PCC and PT. of road curves. Also iron pipes
set at coordinate control points along the West line
and South line of the burial plots and at the radial
points within the burial plots.
Also set iron pipes for control for planting the
concrete monuments at the center of each burial
plot. The lot center monuments have not been set
at this date but shall be set in place when the
landscaping is completed.
