BASIS OF BEARING: Survey No. 1339

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Surveyed tract of land as shown, from monuments found on Oregon St. and C St, being a 5/8 in. iron pin 1 in. deep, a 3/4 in. iron pipe at Oregon &n Calif. 12 ins. deep, a 3/4 in. square bar 8 ins. deep at Calif. & 5th St.

C Street was run parallel to Calif. & 3rd St. was run parallel to Oregon St.

Set a 5/8 in x 24 in. iron pin on the center of C St and 3 rd St. for the City of Jacksonville, at the north corner of the tract surveyed found a 5/8 in. iron pin 4 ins. deep, 29.95 feet from the center line of 3rd St. and 30.02 ft. from the center of C St. this was moved 30.0 ft. from each center line as not enough area to drive a pin along side.

At the NE cor. set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pin flush with the surface.

At the SE & SW cor. made cross on 1 ft. offset.

The easterly line of this property was determined from the approx. mean of outside edge at the corners of the building adjoining on the east and projected to C St. (note, the building corners are somewhat irregular and leaning)
