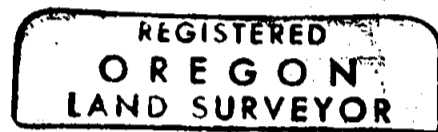
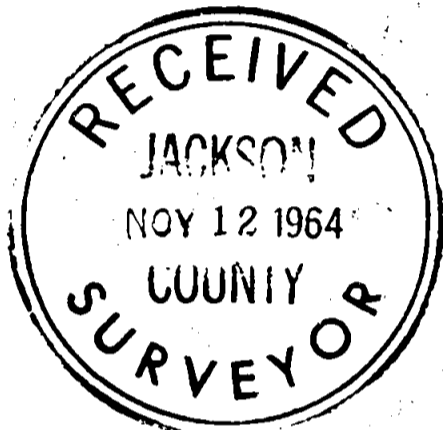
Survey Narrative to comply with par. 209.250 ORS
