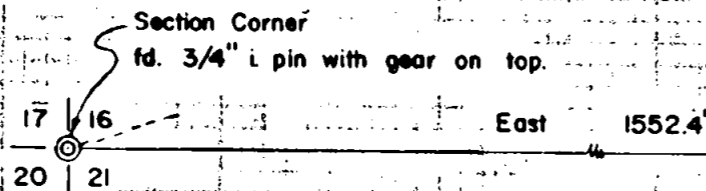

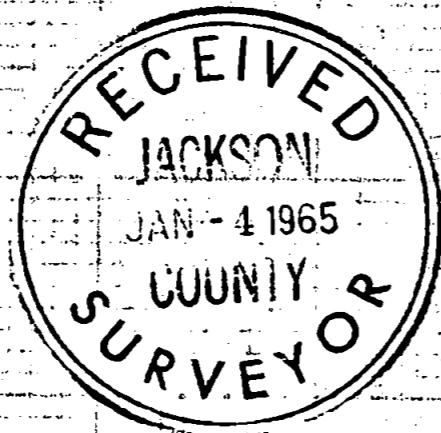

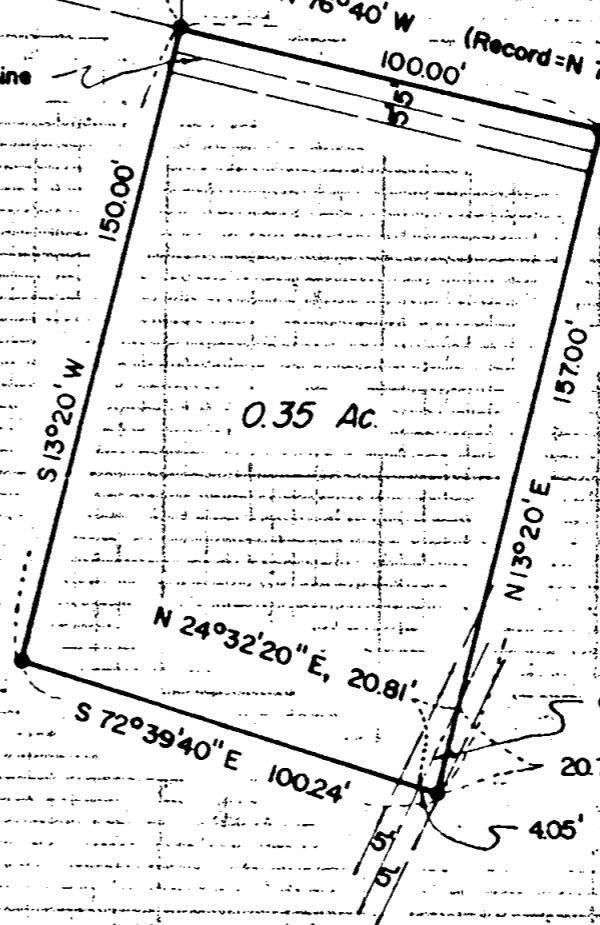

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250  
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a parcel located within the boundaries of tract described in Volume 263, Pages 149 and 150 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

From the section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, and using random points previously set on Recorded Survey No. 2414, for meridian control, traversed Southeasterly to and then around the subject tract.

Iron pins found at Station 90+00 and 100+00 on the Southwesterly boundary of Interstate Highway No. 5 were used for highway boundary control.
