BASIS OF BEARING:



## PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Divided Block 23 of the Railroad Addition to the City of Phoenix, into tracts, as shown. Control for this survey was determined from center line monuments shown on recorded survey No. 142.

- 1. Found a l in. iron pipe, 16 ins. deep
- 2. Found a 1 in. iron pipe 12 ins. deep
- 3. Found a l in. iron pipe 24 ins. deep
- 4. Found a l in. iron pipe 16 ins. deep
- 5. All other monuments set on this survey being 5/8 in. iron pins, 20 ins. long, set flush with the surface.

Note, this survey is conflict with Survey No. 2202, as to location of Block corners. I contacted Mr. L. Ager as to the possible conflict, he informed me that his intention was to use control designated on survey No 142, but thought the monuments may have become lost or destroyed and didn't realize they were buried as deep as they were.
