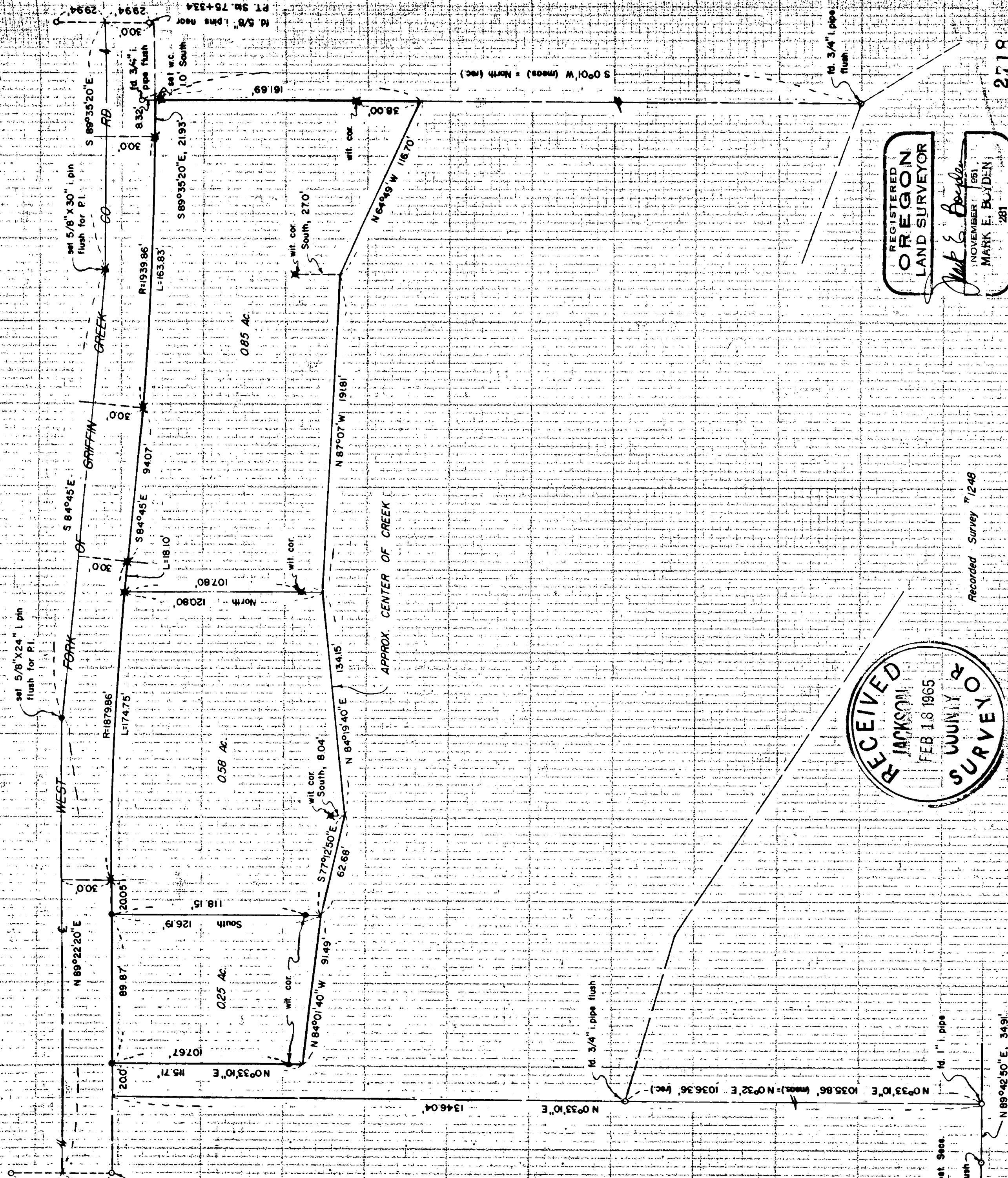

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250,
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: Norman Adkins
West Fork of Griffin Creek Road
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe three parcels within the
Adkins contract ownership described in Volume 559,
Page 150 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Traversed the West Fork of Griffin Creek County Road from
P. T. Station 75 + 33.4 to P. C. Station 89 + 45.79, tying in
right-of-way pins found at the PCs and PTs. All PIs and their
supporting references have been destroyed by road construction
and pins found indicate sizable variance from the record location.

From a mean of evidence found and the record, monumented the
PIs as shown, using the record degree of curvature for control
of the curves.

From the road base line controls, tied in monuments previously
set on Recorded Survey Nos. 1248 and 2701 monumenting the individual
lots as shown.
