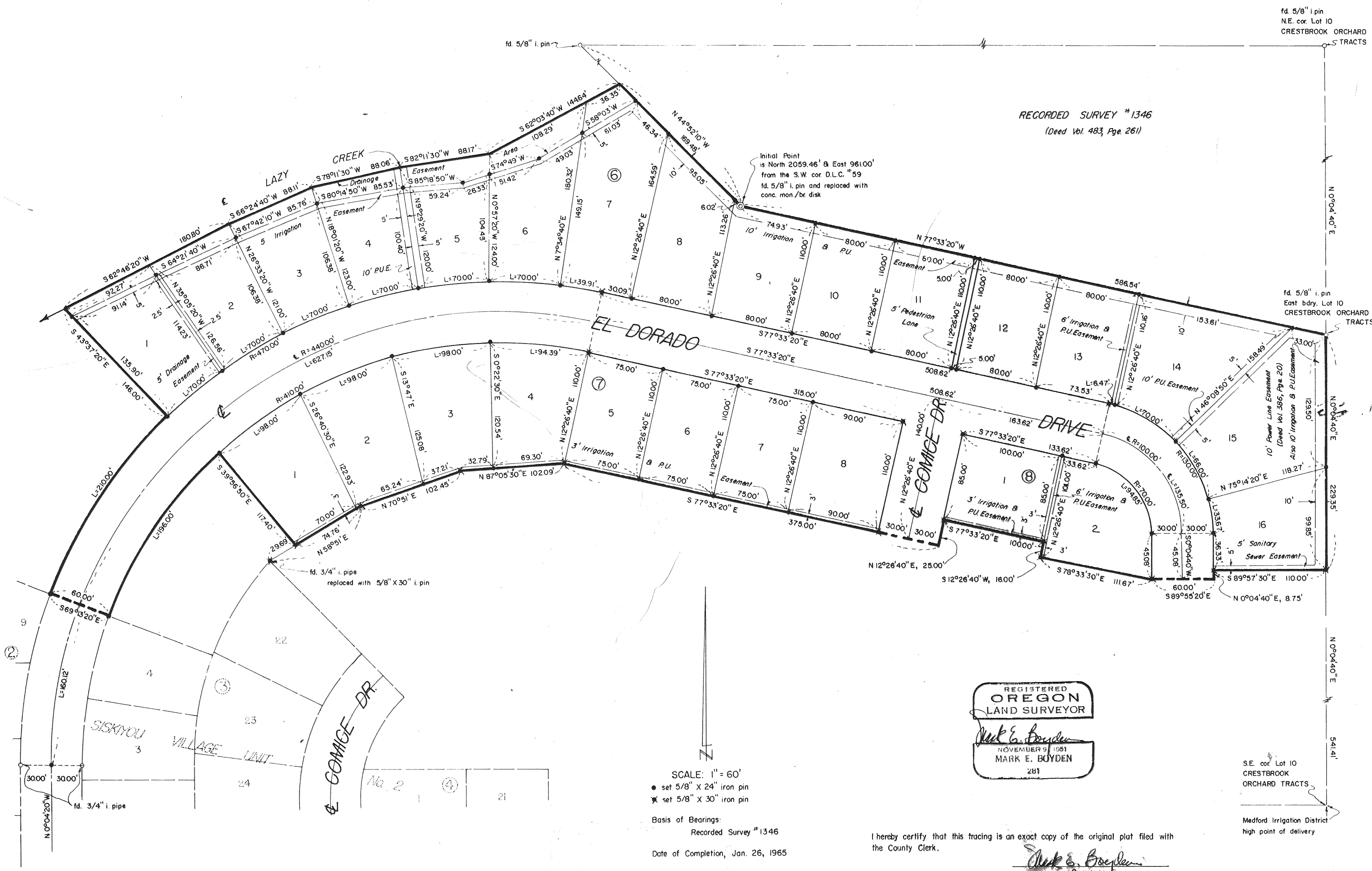

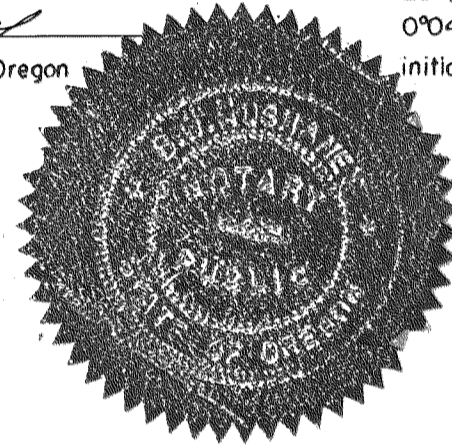

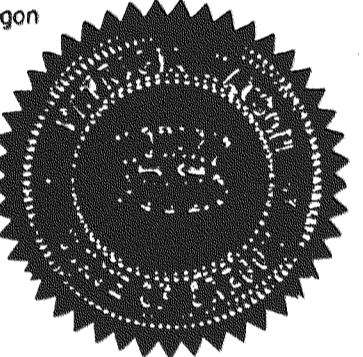

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Mark E. Boyden, a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments as provided by law, the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 59, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence North 2059.46 feet; thence East 961.00 feet to an 8" diameter X 24" concrete monument with brass disk, with top 6" below the ground surface, and being an angle point on the Southwesterly boundary of Tract "A" as described in Volume 483, Page 261 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon for the initial point of beginning; thence North 44°52'10" West, 169.48 feet; thence South 62°03'40" West, 144.64 feet; thence South 82°11'30" West, 88.17 feet; thence South 78°11'30" West, 88.06 feet; thence South 66°24'40" West, 88.11 feet; thence South 62°46'20" West, 180.80 feet; thence South 43°37'20" East, 146.00 feet; thence 210.00 feet along the arc of a curve left (which arc has a radius of 470.00 feet and a long chord of South 33°34'40" West, 208.26 feet) to the Northeast corner of Lot 9, Block 2 of SISKIYOU VILLAGE, UNIT NO. 2 (recorded); thence South 69°13'20" East, 6000 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 3 of said SISKIYOU VILLAGE, UNIT NO. 2; thence 196.00 feet along the arc of a curve right (which arc has a radius of 41000 feet and a long chord of North 34°28'25" East, 194.14 feet); thence South 39°56'50" East, 117.40 feet; thence North 58°51' East, 74.76 feet; thence North 70°51' East, 102.45 feet; thence North 87°05'30" East, 102.09 feet; thence South 77°33'20" East, 375.00 feet; thence North 12°26'40" East, 25.00 feet; thence South 77°33'20" East, 100.00 feet; thence South 12°26'40" West, 1600 feet; thence South 78°33'30" East, 111.67 feet; thence South 89°55'20" East, 60.00 feet; thence North 0°04'40" East, 8.75 feet; thence South 89°57'30" East, 11000 feet to the East boundary of Lot 10, CRESTBROOK ORCHARD TRACTS (recorded); thence North 0°04'40" East, 229.35 feet to the Southeast corner of tract described in deed Volume 483, Page 261; thence North 77°33'20" West, 586.54 feet to the initial point of beginning.

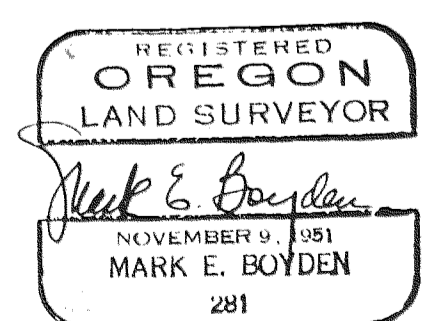
