

- 1. found a stone
- 2. Found a 3/4 in. iron bolt
- 3. Found an iron spike and replaced it with a 1/2 in. iron pipe, 24 ins. long, 4 ins. deep.
- 4. Found a 3/4 in. iron bolt, County rd. r/w monuments.
- 5. Found a l in. hex. gad, 3 ins. high
- 6. Found a 1/2 in. iron pin sflush on sur. No. 2035.
- 7. Found a 5/8 in. iron pin, 6 ins. high and all other monuments set being  $5/8 \times 24$  in. iron pins, set flush with the surface.

The westerly line of Section, as shown, is sonly approx. and the distances therefrom.

At request of client divided land, the most southerly dine of the southerly tract was determined from previous survey information and deed records.
