BASIS OF BEARING: Survey No. 1447.

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Monuments:

All monuments set being 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pins, flush with the surface.

- 1. On survey 1447 set a 1/2 in. iron pin, 20 ft. west of SSE. GLC 57 cor. Found that the re-established SSE cor, by County Surveyor, measured 20.07 ft. from 1/2 in. iron pin indicates monuments 0.07 ft. east of cor.
- 2. Iron pipe f (plus or minus) 4.52 ft. southerly being of survey No. 2688.

 This survey being in conflict with previous survey No. 2688, notified Boyden of Difference.
- 3. Monument falls at southerly edge of old fence post (note, according to a resident of nearly 15 yrs. he had found old monument at fence cor. when he purchased tract and it may have been removed during improvement on irrigation ditch.
- 4. From iron pin near fence corn. found a 3/4 in. iron pipe, approx. 0.23 ft. south and 0.76 ft. East.

Most of the older deeds, even deed calls as far as a 1/2 mile north, and records indicate the east line of DLC 57 being North, using this as a basis of bearing for deeds retraced deed records and set monuments as shown.

The existing fence would agree with the procedure followed.

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
