Written narrative to accompany plat for Survey No. 2789
Survey for Mr. James C. Nixtler , 406 W. Main St. Medford, Oregon.
Date March 29. 1965 Scale 1" = 100'

Purpose to stake out lots on Experimental Station Road.
Procedure: A check with the County Engineer's office showed a question mark for the status of Experimentsl Station Road. Farther checks was run with the title companies, an no information was available. Mr. Lovejoy on survey NO. 1073 and an adjacent survey had previously set up a street pattern, and some deed records mention a 40 foot roadway

therefor deed tie was ran from the Southwest corner of D.L.C. No 37 and distance was adjusted slightly for angle check against points found to come up with the best possible answer to the situation. (that was for frontage check on Kings Highway to a record distance check from the 3" brass cap monument some 1266 feet east of Kings Highway.

From this information 5/8" bars were set flush to the ground for corners to the lots in question. as shown on the plat.
