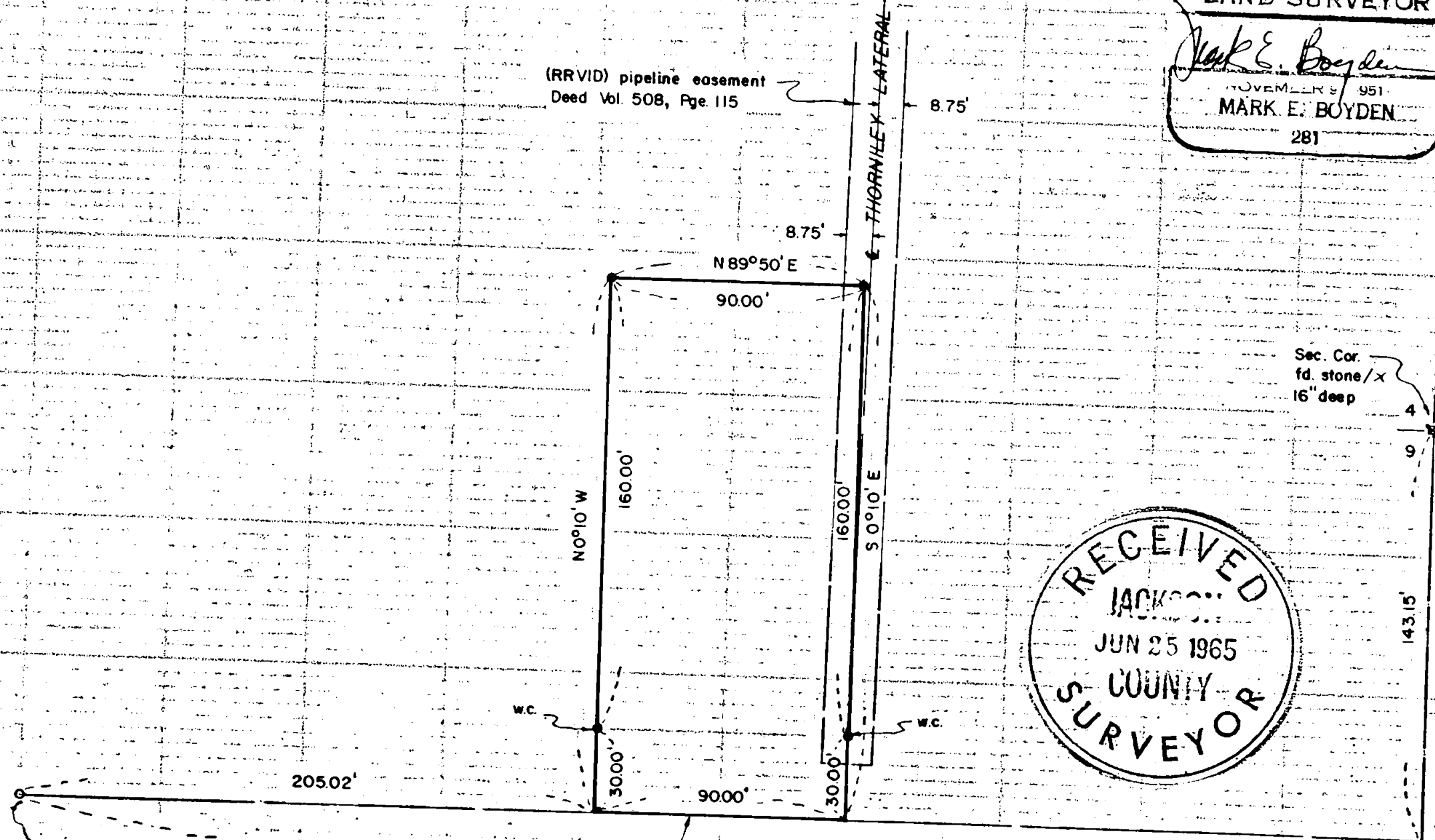
THORNILEY LATERAL

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a parcel within tract
described in Volume 560, Page 121, of the Deed

PROCEDURE:

Found section and donation land claim corner monuments
previously re-established by the County Surveyor's office,
as shown.

By transit-chain measurements, ran from the Northwest
corner of DLC #52, to and around the subject tract, monumenting
same as shown.

NOTE: No attempt was made to determine the true centerline
of Taylor County Road.
