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Survey Narrative to comply with, O.R.S. 209-250:

Walter Anderson & L. Buck Survey for: Rogue River, Oregon

BASIS OF BEARING: Survey No. 1930.

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PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Monuments.

- 1. Found a 3/4 in. iron pipe, 8 ins. deep at the SE. cor. of Sec. 16
- Found a 1/2 in. iron pipe, 3 ins. deep at P.I.
- Found a 1/2 in. iron pipe, 10 ins. deep
- 4. Set a 1/2 x 24 ins. iron pipe, 6 ins. deep at P.I. of a curve (center line of pavement having a radius of approx. 120 ft.)
- 5. R.R. spike in pavement, approx. center line of County rd.
- 6. Found a 3/4 in. iron pin, 12 ins. deep.
- 7. Found a 3/4 in. iron pin, 3 ins. high, 49.2 ft. from center line of existing railroad tract. .
- 8. Set a $1/2 \times 24$ in. iron pipe, flush with the surface, 50 ft. from center line of existing railroad track.
- 9. Set a $5/8 \times 24$ in. iron pin flush with the surface.


Other monuments being 1/2 in. iron pipes, 24 ins. long set Islush with the surface. Center line of Foothill Blvd. determined from County road datum from point 3 to 4. From point 4 to 5 is an approx. center line.

The purpose of survey was to determine lines of occupancy or possession between the owners.

Line 6 - 7, agreed on by owners, Anderson & Breeding Line 9 - 10, agreed on by owners Buck & Anderson

Line 8 - 9, Tentative line monumental on old fence line.

No attempt was made to determine exact right of way of Southern Pacific rail road right of way.



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
