Found original BT to NE with & S scribe damaged by fire etc. (see records)

22" Black Oak bears N53½E 21.1 ft.; now 26", scribes CS BT.
14" Black Oak bears S40¼W 96.6 ft.; now 20", face covered.
6" x 6" granite stone bears S24½E 5.2 ft.; found in place, large X en top.
