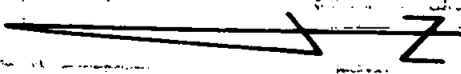

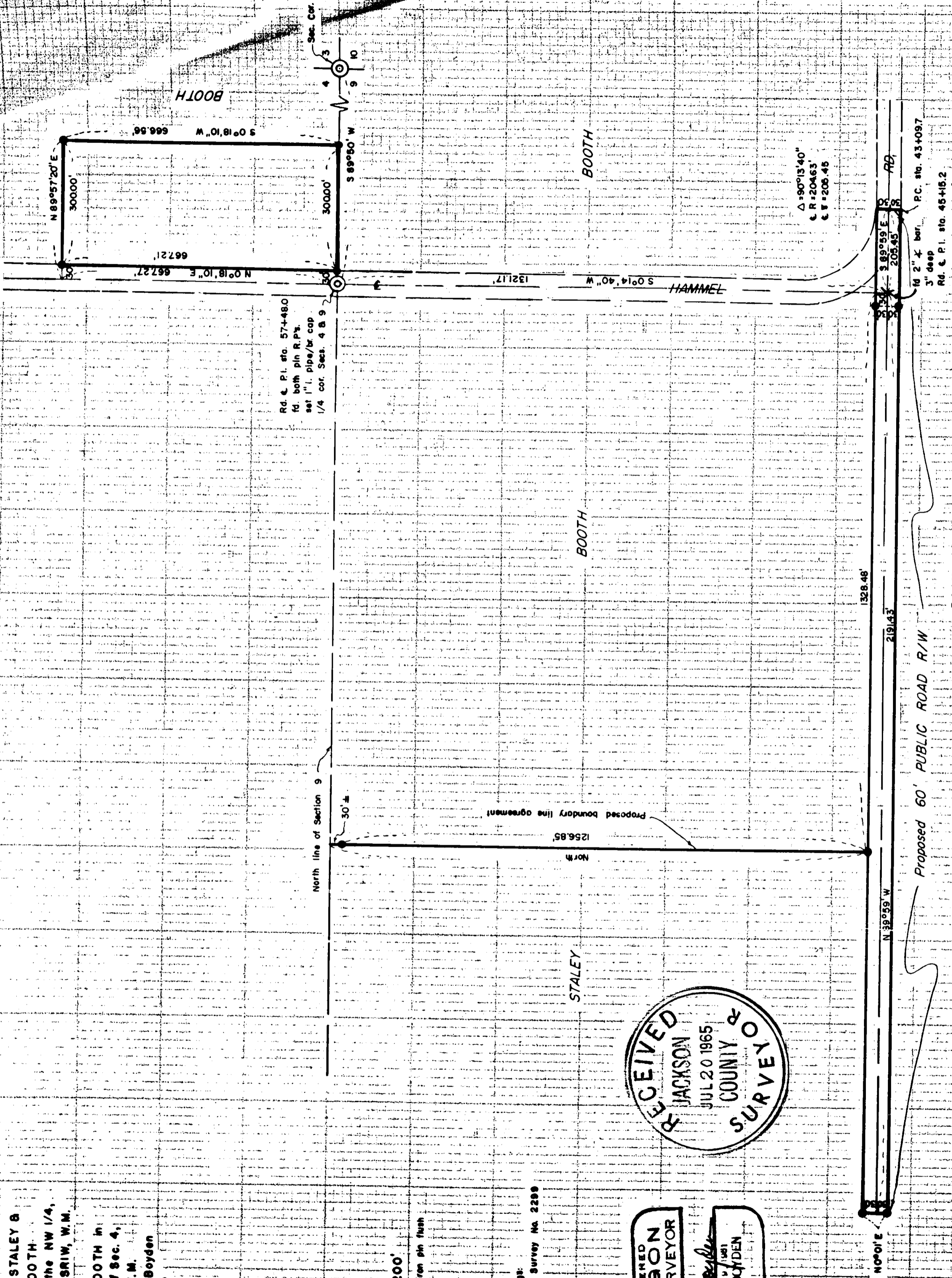

PURPOSE: (1) To monument and describe a proposed 60-foot wide public road Westerly from Hammel Road P.C. Station 43+09.7 through the Staley and Booth properties.
(2) Monument and describe an agreement boundary between said parties, said boundary being in the vicinity of the West boundary of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West.
(3) To monument and describe a parcel within the Booth contract ownership in Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian.

PROCEDURE:

From controls previously set on Recorded Survey No. 2299, traversed Westerly and Northerly along Hammel Road, tying in the 1934 road-survey controls as shown. Also ran Westerly and thence Southwesterly to the tie in the re-established quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 9.

After a conference with the subject parties, monumented the boundaries agreed upon as shown on the attached map.
