


1/4 COR.





Bearing : Based on meridian of Recorded Survey No. 2486

Purpose : 1. To separate the small tract shown from Block "J" of the unrecorded Overlook Addition.
2. To locate and define the right-of-way of a 47' wide street as shown.



PROCEDURE

From deed line right-of-way monuments found East of the surveyed tract, centerline control was carried across Block "J" to conform, generally, with that of an existing road.

Boundary control for the east side of the premises was held 650 feet East of the section line and parallel thereto in conformity with dimensions of the Overlook Addition.

The south line has been previously established during the course of surveys for Timberline and Casa Madrona Subdivisions, record bearing of which was held from survey control previously established.

Survey completed July 26, 1965.
