SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

LOCATION: Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, W.M., Oregon

PURPOSE; To subdivide the tract of land shown into lots, blocks and streets, subdivision designated as BELLVIEW HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION.

PROCEEDURE: This tract had been previously surveyed and monuments set at the boundary corners. Found a 2 inch iron pipe at the Southwest corner of the tract, said pipe being cast iron and of insufficent length, I replaced it with a 2inch by 36 inch galvanized pipe for the initial point, from this I retraced the boundaries of the tract and subdivided same.
