SURVEY NARRATIVE to Accompany Plat of Land of Many Oaks No. 3

C.W. Duggan 3152 Tresham Lane Central Point

The Center Quarter Corner of Section 33, Township 35 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, as located from a previous survey by this office, (as yet unrecorded) was used as the Initial Point for this subdivision, a concrete monument with metal tablet being set at this point.

The most easterly boundary was then established along the North-South center line of said Section 33 to an intersection with an East west fence. By mutual agreement of the land owners involved, the property line was then established approximately 4 inches southwesterly from the fences as constructed, following said fence line at the bearings and distances as shown on the accompanying plat to an intersection with the southeasterly right of way line of States Highway

No. 234. Deed descriptions were written to conform with the survey location of property lines.

The northwesterly boundary of this subdivision is the southeasterly right of way line of said Highway No. 234, proceeding southwest along said right of way as described in the "Surveyors Certificate", to an intersection of the right of way line as monumented, with the northeasterly line of "Land of Many Oaks", a recorded subdivision.
