


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SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

The NW corner of the property being surveyed is monumented by a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin set in concrete, which is offset $1\frac{5}{2}$ south from the corner along the west property line and a 1" iron pin set in concrete offset $1\frac{5}{2}$ East of the corner on the North property line.

Seven other corners were monumemted by 1" iron pins set in concrete. The iron pin marking the SE corner of the property being surveyed is set 0.70' South from an iron pin marking the SE corner of the property in V. 478, Pg 89. The old pin was left undisturbed.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FDR: Pacific Power & Light Co. 216 West Main Street Medford, Oregon

LOCATION: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a tract of land lying North of Highway 66, and South of the South Line of D.L.C. 53 in the SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian

PROCEDURE:

The NE corner of D.L.C. #54 and the SE corner of D.L.C. #53, both in Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian Jackson County, Oregon, as described in the property survey record No. 2149 by Mr. Ager are found. A house has been budlt on the line between the two D.L.C. corners, so, a parallel offset which is 31.77' from the D.L.C. line in a Southerly direction is set up. The offset line is proven to be truly parallel by retying the D.L.C. corners. The bearing of this line is found, by solar observations, to be South 83937'30" East instead of the due East bearing which was recorded. The solar observations were taken on April 27, 1964 at North line of property being surveyed. Two other solars taken along the proposed centerline of a transmission line approximately one mile from the property surveyed verified these solars. following information was obtained; Latitude 42°10.6' and split between solars was 12 seconds. The recorded distance between the D.L.C. corners is checked and found to be correct. A closed traverse is run around the area to be surveyed tying the found corners as we went. The traverse closed 1/10,000. The angles closed flat. The new corners are set from this traverse. The pipe marking the NW corner of the property in Deed Records V. 406, Pg. 468 has been lost, a fence post now occupying its original position. The pipes marking the NW corner and the SW corner of the property in Deed Records V. 400 d and found to be correct in distance and bearing. A bearing tie along the centerline stripe of Highway #66 shows the highway bearing to be North 60°13'30" West instead of the recorded bearing North 60°35'40" The iron pin marking the SE corner of the property in Deed Records V. Pg. 89 is tied. This distance is found to be 0.70' short.

The NW corner of the property being surveyed is monumented by a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin set in concrete, which is offset $1\frac{5}{2}$ south from the corner along the west property line and a 1" iron pin set in concrete offset $1\frac{5}{2}$ East of the corner on the North property line.

Seven other corners were monumented by 1" iron pins set in concrete. The iron pin marking the SE corner of the property being surveyed is set 0.70' South from an iron pin marking the SE corner of the property in V. 478, Pg 89. The old pin was left undisturbed.

LOCATION: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a tract of land lying North of Highway 66, and South of the South Line of D.L.C. 53 in the SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 South. Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian

PROCEDURE:

The NE corner of D.L.C. #54 and the SE corner of D.L.C. #53, both in Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian Jackson County, Oregan, as described in the property survey record No. 2149 by Mr. Ager are found. A house has been built on the line between the two D.L.C. corners. so, a parallel offset which is 31.77' from the D.L.C. line in a Southerly direction is set up. The offset line is proven to be truly parallel by retying the D.L.C. corners. The bearing of this line is found, by solar observations, to be South 83037'30" East instead of the due East bearing which was recorded. The solar observations were taken on April 27, 1964 at North line of property being surveyed. Two other solars taken along the proposed centerline of a transmission line approximately one mile from the property surveyed verified these solars. following information was obtained; Latitude 42010.6' and split between solars was 12 seconds. The recorded distance between the D.L.C. corners is checked and found to be correct. A closed traverse is run around the area to be surveyed tying the found corners as we went. The traverse closed 1/10,000. The angles closed flat. The new corners are set from this traverse. pipe marking the NW corner of the property in Deed Records V. 406, Pg. 468 has been lost, a fence post now occupying its original position. The pipes marking the NW corner and the SW corner of the property in Deed Records V. 400, Pg. 322 were tied and found to be correct in distance and bearing. A bearing tie along the centerline stripe of Highway #66 shows the highway bearing to be North 60°13'36" West instead of the recorded bearing North 60°35'40" West. The iron pin marking the SE corner of the property in Deed Records V. 478 Pg. 89 is tied. This distance is found to be 0.70' short.
