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## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH Q.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, Q.L. 1963

For:

Hazel Wolfe 322 Benson St. Medford, Oregon

Purpose:

To survey and monument two parcels in Lot 14 of WOLFE SUBDIVISION (Unrecorded), east of recently constructed Columbus Ave.

PROCEDURE:

A search for monuments at the westerly corners of Lots 1 through 13, Wolfe Subdivision, was made, with the following monuments being found at or near the true locations:

Final line was determined by establishing a parallel to the center line of Benson Street, and using the pin called for in various deeds as being North  $89^{\circ}59^{\circ}$  West, 183.3 feet from the center line of Benson Street. In establishing said parallel, it was found that the 1" Iron Bar at the southeast corner of Lot 14 checked for angle, and chained 253.05 from the  $\frac{5}{6}$ " Iron pin against a deed record of 253.00 feet.

The east-west lines were surveyed parallel to Prune Street.

Columbus Avenue was located from a detailed plan drawing furnished by Medford City Engineers (drawing no. not furnished).

The center line of Benson Street was determined from data in City Engineers Book 770, pages 3 and 4. The present center line of intersection of Benson and Prune is monumented by a spike, 5.00 feet West of a concrete monument with copper plug for original center line North, and 5.70 feet West of another concrete monument with copper plug for the center line of Benson St. South.
