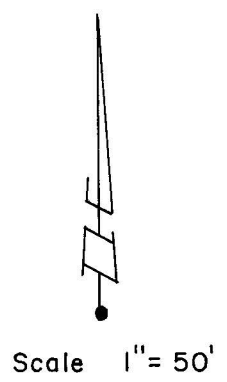
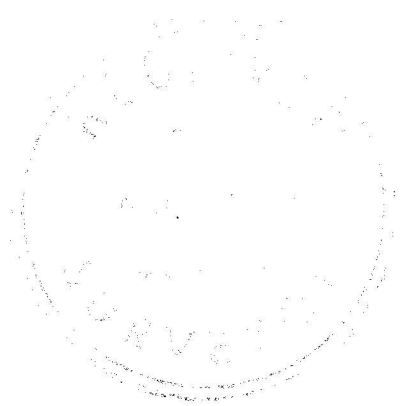
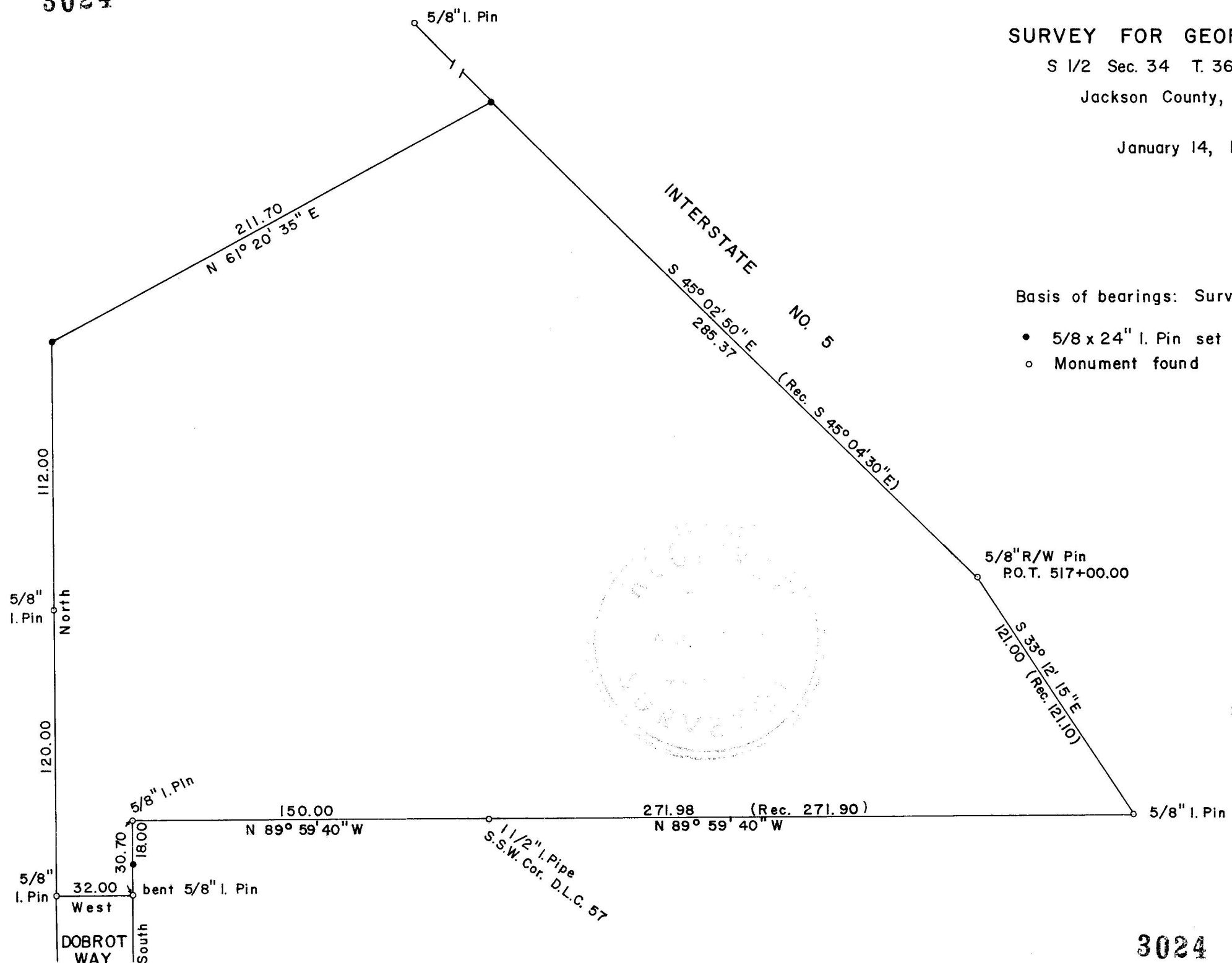

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To partition tract surveyed in Recorded Survey No. 1410 into two parcels as directed by client.

PROCEDURE: Recovered property monuments as indicated, and set corners as shown on the accompanying plat. Measured angles result in bearing along Interstate 5 of S 45°02'50" E rather than S 45°04'30" E as recorded in said Survey 1410. Coordinate closure also seems to verify the results of this survey.
