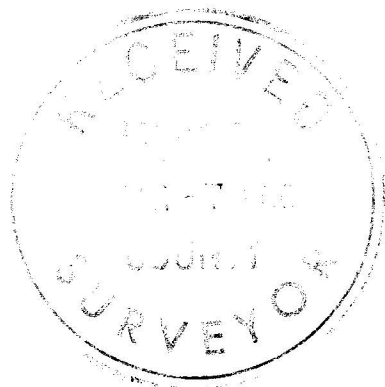
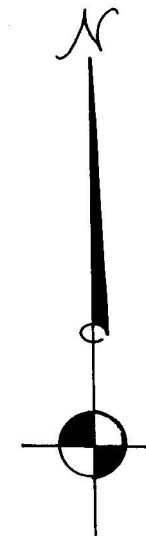

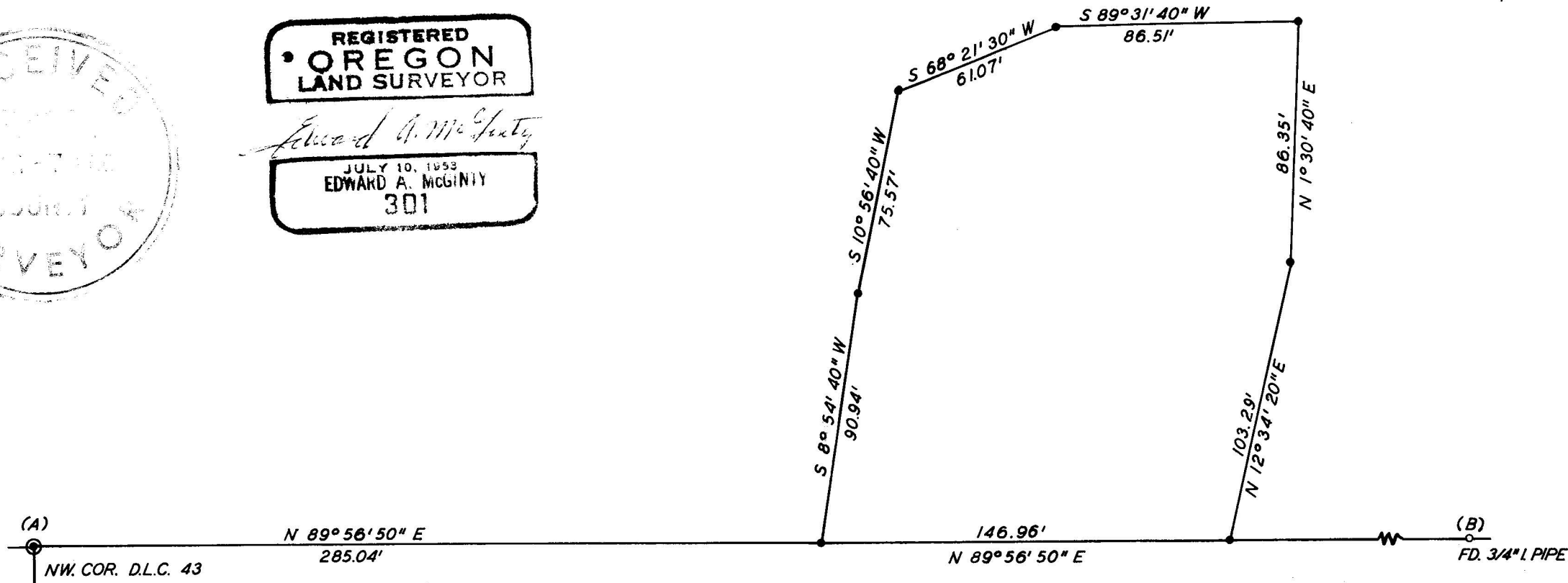
SCALE 1" = 50'

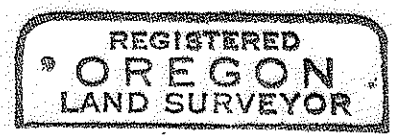
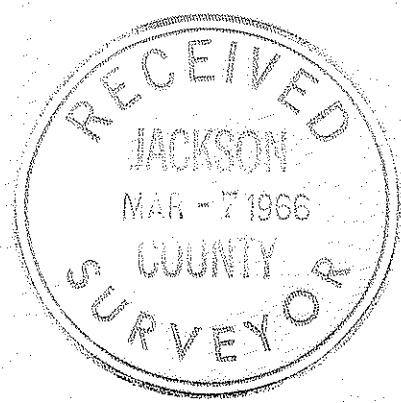
Monuments:

- (A). Found 2 inch iron pipe 6 inches deep at the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. 43.
- (B). Found 3/4 inch iron pipe 6 inches deep (shown on Survey No. 1914 as being of D.L.C. line.)

Monuments set on this survey being 5/8 x 20 inch iron pins set approx. flush with the surface.
