



PROCEDURE:


Found control monuments previously set by this office on Recorded Survey No. 1044 to determine the tie to the North-Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 42.

Traversed Westerly from said control points to and around the subject parcel.

Ties were made to State right-of-way pins along the Northeasterly line of Interstate 5 and the pin shown found at Station 7+50 on Fern Valley Road. These ties were then coordinated with the State right-of-way descriptions that tied to the "Northeast" corner of DLC #42, which checked said tie within reasonable limits.

It should be noted that the deed bearings in this area are all referred to as "South". It is our belief that the intention was to run South parallel with the East boundary of DLC #42, which by bearings of solar origin shown on Recorded Survey No. 1044 is South 0° 08' 30" West.

Monumented the desired tract corners with 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe.
