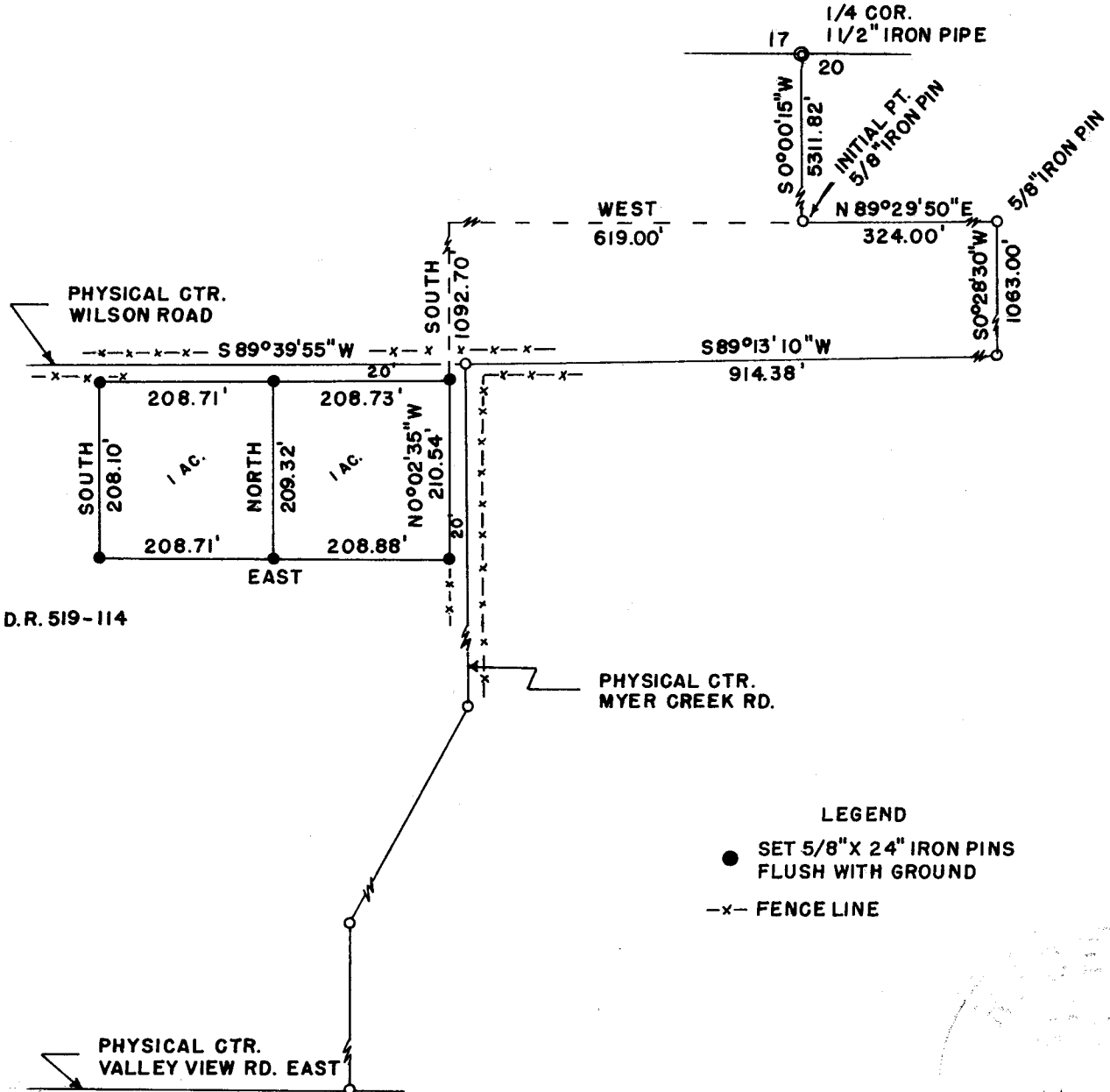

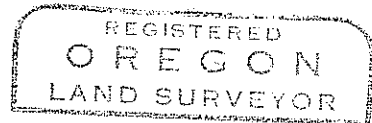
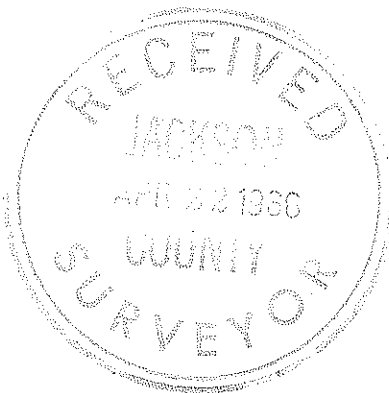
Purpose: To separate the tracts shown and monument the boundaries thereof.

Procedure: Per client's instructions; the tracts shown were separated from the northeast corner of that tract of land described in Deed Record 519 - 114.

Initially, it was explained that the lack of original survey control in this area would probably cause the retracement of the centerline of Wilson and Myers Creek roads economically not feasible.

This proved to be the case. Accordingly, the existing or physical road location was held in place and those pins set at roadside should be considered controlling for direction of those boundaries shown not abutting said roads.
