

Survey Narrative to comply with O.R.S. 209-250:

BASIS OF BEARING: Solar Observation.

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Surveyed the west 660 feet of the south 1650 feet of the Southwest quarter, according to the description furnished by client.

Monuments used for control.

A. At the west 1/4 cor. found an old 1/2 in. iron pipe, 18 ins. long, about 12 ins. deep and bent over, replaced said pipe with a 5/8 in.

X 24 in. iron pin, 6 ins. deep (layed the old pipe along the westerly side) from which

The center of the original BT. a white oak, now 30 ins. diam., bears S. 47°W., $\frac{57.9}{57.9}$ ft. (note, center badly decayed, found old axe blazes) $\frac{53.9}{47}$ ft. ϵ_{299}

Center of white oak, 10 ins. diam., bears East, 53.8 ft. (not scribed)

B. At the SW. cor. Sec. 30, found a 2 in. iron pipe, 6 ins. deep

Center of black oak, BT bears N. 40°50'E., 70.2 ft.

Iron pin in conc. abuttment bears N. 81°45'E., 70.80 ft, instead of N. 82°30'W., 70.65 ft.

Center of white oak, BT bears S. 78°19'E., 21.3 ft.

C. At the SE. cor. of Sec. 30, set a 5/8 in. iron pin x 24 ins. long, 3 ins. deep, from which

center of BO, BT, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 17°00'W., 92.8 ft. center of BO BT, 40 ins. diam., bears N. $36\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 76.9 ft. center of BO BT, 26 ins. diam., S. 32°W., 46.9 ft.

Remarks: found bearing objects at the S 1/4 cor. using said distance called for, point of intersection fell approx. 0.40 ft. south of section line.
