

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.H.S. 209.250

FOR: John D. Murphy, 145 Alida Street, Ashland, Oregon.

LOCATION: Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

PURPOSE: To monument the boundary corners of tract shown on map.

PROCEEDURE:

The granite stone with + on top shown for the corner of Sections 19,20,29 and 30 has been used as such over 20 years to my knowledge as it was in place in 1945 when I retraced the North and West lines of Section 29.

From this corner I ran a random line to the Quarter corner between Sections 29 and 30, tieing in an iron pipe at the approx. 1/16 th corner. I found this pipe to be on true line and midway between the Section corner and the Quarter corner. At the Quarter corner I found the stumps of the original bearing trees intact, scribe visible. Found a 1% inch in place for corner which I used for true corner.

Along the North-South 1/4 line I found iron pipes as shown on map, which I used for control.

Solar taken for bearing June 20, 1966 at 3:45 P.M. Pacific Standard Time.


