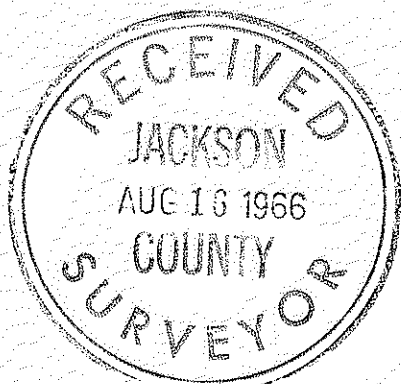
SURVEY FOR: Mr. E.G. Fjarli  
4017 Jacksonville Highway  
Medford, Oregon

LOCATION: The tract situated in Sections 27 and 28, also  
Donation Land Claims No. 93 and 67, Township 37  
South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson  
County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument the corners and describe the boundaries  
of the tract indicated on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The description of the parent tract described in  
Jackson County Deed Records Volume 250 page 303 is  
described from the Northeast corner of Donation Land  
Claim No. 93, thence North 7.63 chains which compares with the  
record calls and it was assumed for the purpose of this survey that  
the intent of this call was to describe a course along the West  
line of Donation Land Claim No. 74 and terminating at the Northwest  
corner of Donation Land Claim No. 74. By reason that the re-  
established position of this corner is in dispute at the present  
time, the Northwest corner of Parry Subdivision was tied and con-  
sidered. To position the West line of the tract a record distance  
of 13.37 chains was used from the re-established corner position  
because the dispute has a negligible effect in the easting location.  
The North line of the tract was controlled by the Oregon State  
Highway right of way deed as described in Deed Record Volume 497  
page 127 which is based on the existing center line of the Medford-  
Provolt Highway. The South and East lines were positioned by the  
client. Basis of bearings--Recorded Survey No. 3028.
