

Survey Narrative To Comply With Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Southeast One Quarter (1/4) of the Northwest One Quarter (1/4) of Section 3, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE & PROCEDURE: The purpose of the survey was to monument and describe the parcels of land originally conveyed by title and contract from the tract

described in Jackson County Deed Record Volume 354, page 159. This description first appeared in a Quit Claim Deed recorded in Volume 162, page 285. The bearings and distances contained in the description are incorrect. The party preparing the legal descriptions of the partitioned tracts used the original description (162/285) as a basis for the intermediate tracts, therefore all of the descriptions were incorrect. The bearings of the South line of the tract is North 88° 40' West, the adjacent tract calls for a bearing of due West. The existing fence line which has been the accepted line for the past many years bears South 89° 37' 40" West. To eliminate the vacancy created by the erroneous bearing a quit claim deed was obtained and recorded in Volume 579, page 430-431, also a quit claim deed was obtained from the two Westerly tracts on the South side of the fence line recorded by Jackson County Instrument No. 66-06053, the Easterly portion of the line was described and monumented on the record line. An additional instrument was prepared and was signed by the sub-tract owners quit-claiming the land held by the erroneous deeds and contracts to the subdivider, Mr. Eli Davis. Mr. Davis in turn re-conveyed by the new descriptions to all tract owners. The control found and used and the details for the new descriptions are shown on the attached map. Basis of bearings--Recorded Survey No. 1556.
