Purpose

To monument the corners of the tract shown and define

the boundaries thereof.


Procedure

Said tract was monumented on the basis of that description per Volume 561, page 214 of Deed Records, Jackson County, Oregon. The north and south boundary was determined by holding record angle from the D.L.C. line running down the physical center of Ross Lane.

It was determined that said tract falls within the boundaries of the Jo Jack Subdivision (unrecorded) which was surveyed by Herman Powell some years ago. It is suspected that some survey control for this unrecorded subdivision exists and that deeds were written from such control. Should this prove to be the case, the element of proportionate remeasurement would be involved.

This procedure was explained to the client who felt that since deed record fits existing improvements, the expense of additional survey work was not justified in order to determine if, in fact, some excess or deficiency might apply to the tract involved.
