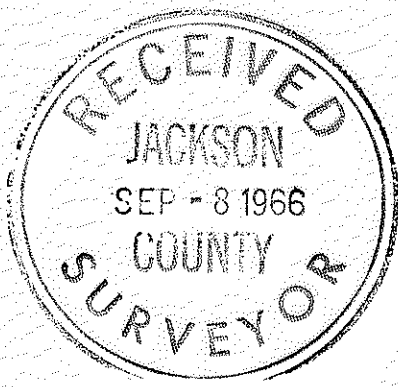
SURVEY FOR: K.M.E.D. Radio & Television

LOCATION: Tract situated in the Northeast One Quarter
(1/4) of the Northeast One Quarter (1/4) of
Section 20, Township 40 South, Range 1 East,
Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument the corners and describe the parcel
of land indicated on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The United States Coast and Geodetic Survey
triangulation station (Mt. Ashland) was occupied and an angular
tie was made to the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey azimuth
monument for bearing control, a traverse was run to the section
corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, thence to and around
the perimeter of the parcel as indicated. Basis of bearings--United
States Coast and Geodetic Survey azimuth data.
