




Basis of Bearing: Survey for Robert J. O'Connell and M. Fall, by Edward McGinty, Feb., 1966

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument three residential parcels in "RESUBDIVISION".

PROCEDURE: - A recent survey (unrecorded as of this date) was obtained from Mr.

Edward McGinty, Licensed Surveyor, which tied the southwest, northwest, and northeast corners of the original "PERRY SUBDIVISION IN

D.L.C. 74, T. 37 S., R. 2 W" together. Mr. McGinty had recovered
the original subdivision corners for this survey. Using the north
line of said Subdivision as a basis for bearings, the southeast corner
monument was tied in. The bearing and distance of the south boundary
was then computed from this combined survey data.

The "RESUBDIVISION OF PARTMOF PERRY SUBDIVISION" was then located, using pro-rate data obtained from the above described procedure. An analysis of said "RESUBDIVISION" plat revealed several anomalies, and would not seem to be consistent with the original PERRY SUBDIVISION plat, filed only fourteen months earlier. Since the "RESUBDIVISION plat was, by definition," the East 30.0 feet of Lot 10, and all of Lts 11 and 12 of PERRY SUBDIVISION (see Plat description), this is the description accepted, and the location of said Lots was determined accordingly.

The parcel to be divided was found to have been monumented in an unrecorded Survey by Mr. Ingle, Registered Engineer, some years ago. as follows:
