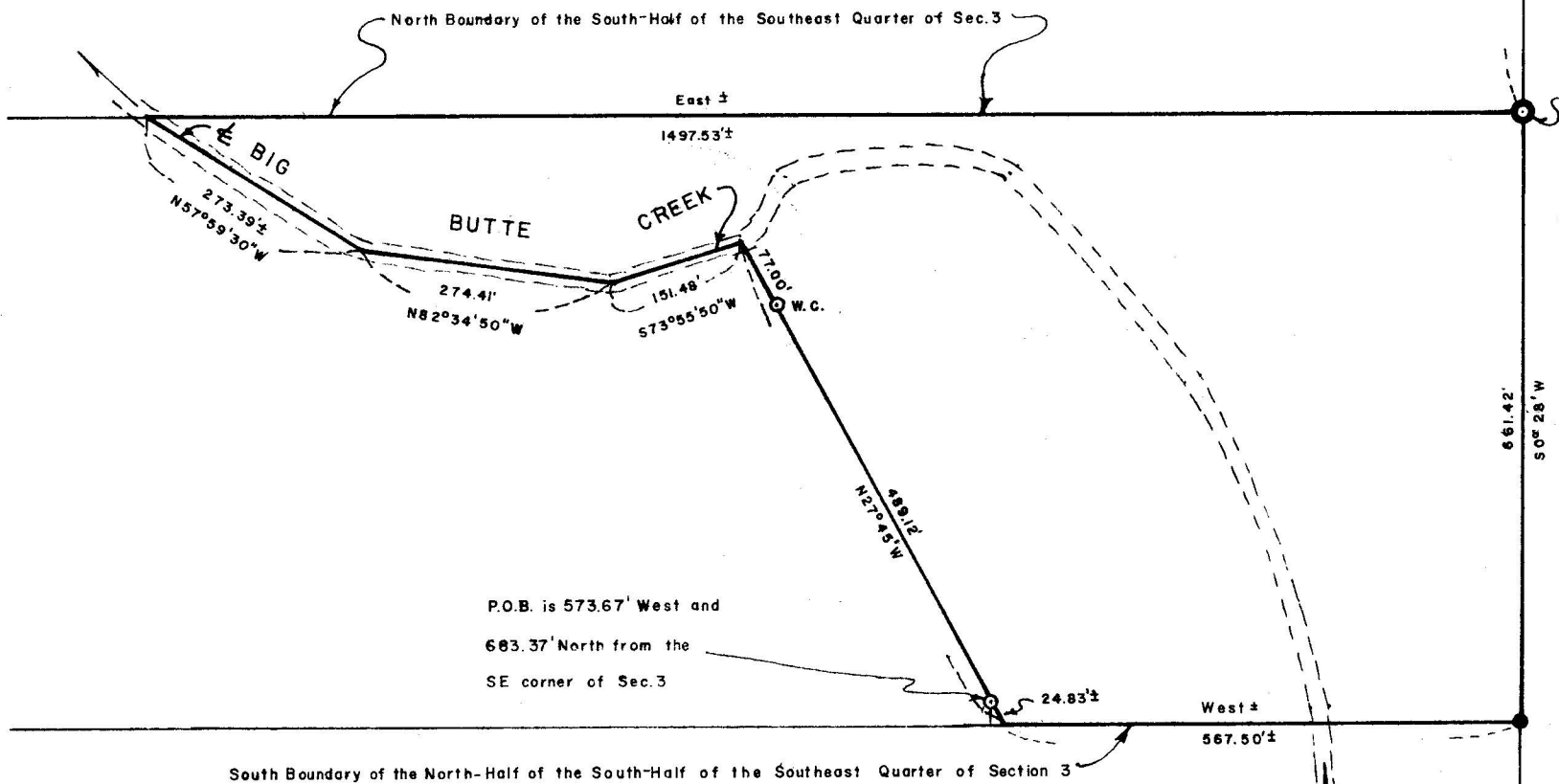

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: Jackson County Parks & Recreation
Courthouse
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a portion of the North-half of the South-half of the Southeast quarter of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, proposed to be conveyed to Jackson County.

PROCEDURE:

Since a complete subdivision of Section 3 was not warranted for the purpose of this survey, a traverse was run between the Southeast corner and the East quarter corner, of Section 3.

The South one-sixteenth corner and the South-South one-sixty-fourth corner were accurately set on proportional distances.

The description boundary was computed on the basis of a due West line from these corners and described with "more-or-less" distances, subject to change when the section is completely subdivided.

Monuments were set as shown on the map to accompany this report.
