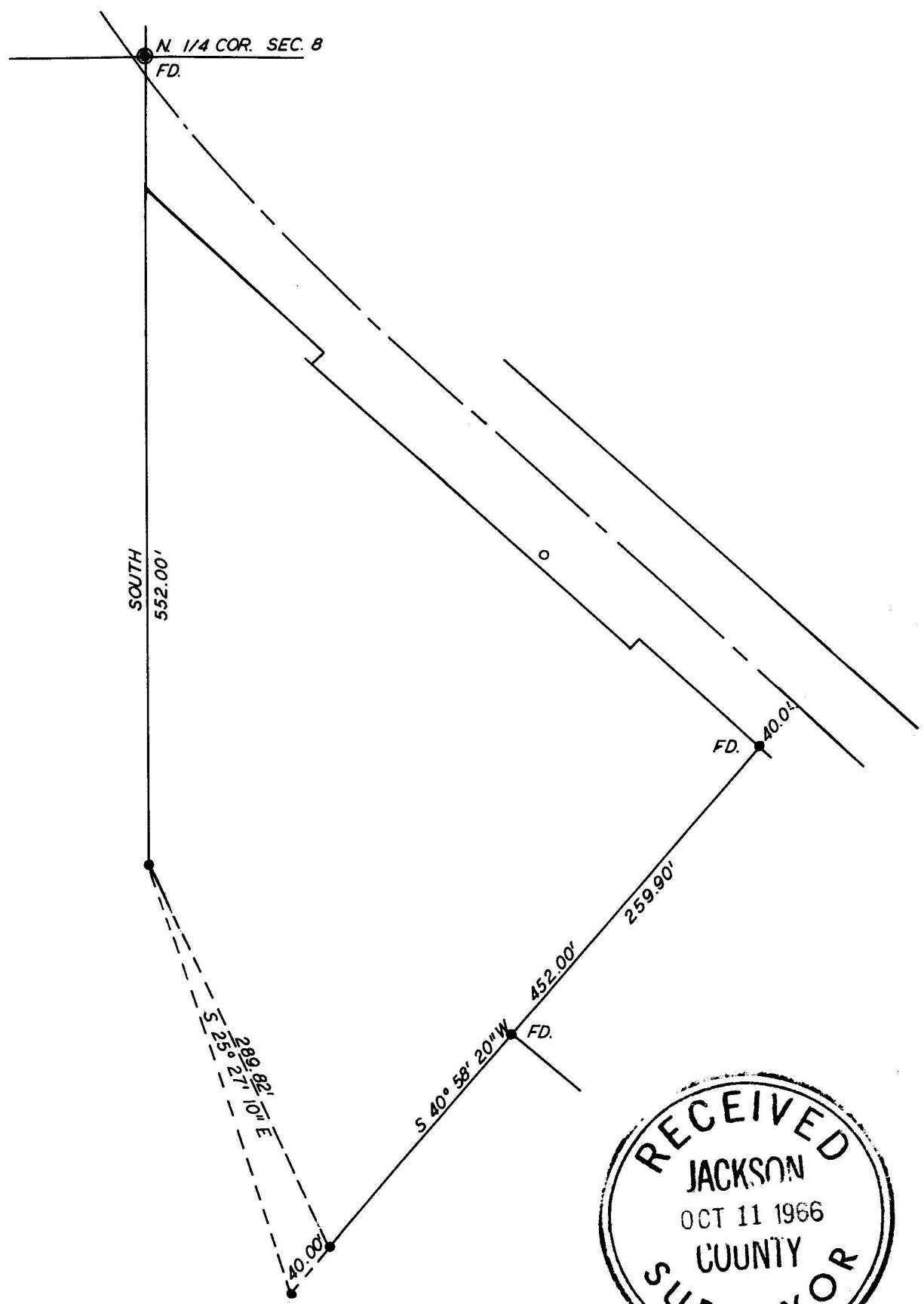

BASIS OF BEARING: Solar Observation

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

At the request of client, he wanted to know approximately where the boundaries of the tract would be.

From the North one quarter corner now existing (Note: according to deed records, Vol. 431, page 434, and Highway maps and owners having indicated the corner to be West of now existing Highway) ran a line South, 522.00 feet.

From monuments found (highway) projected this line Southerly as shown.

Monuments set being 5/8 x 20 inch iron pins, set approximately flush with surface.
