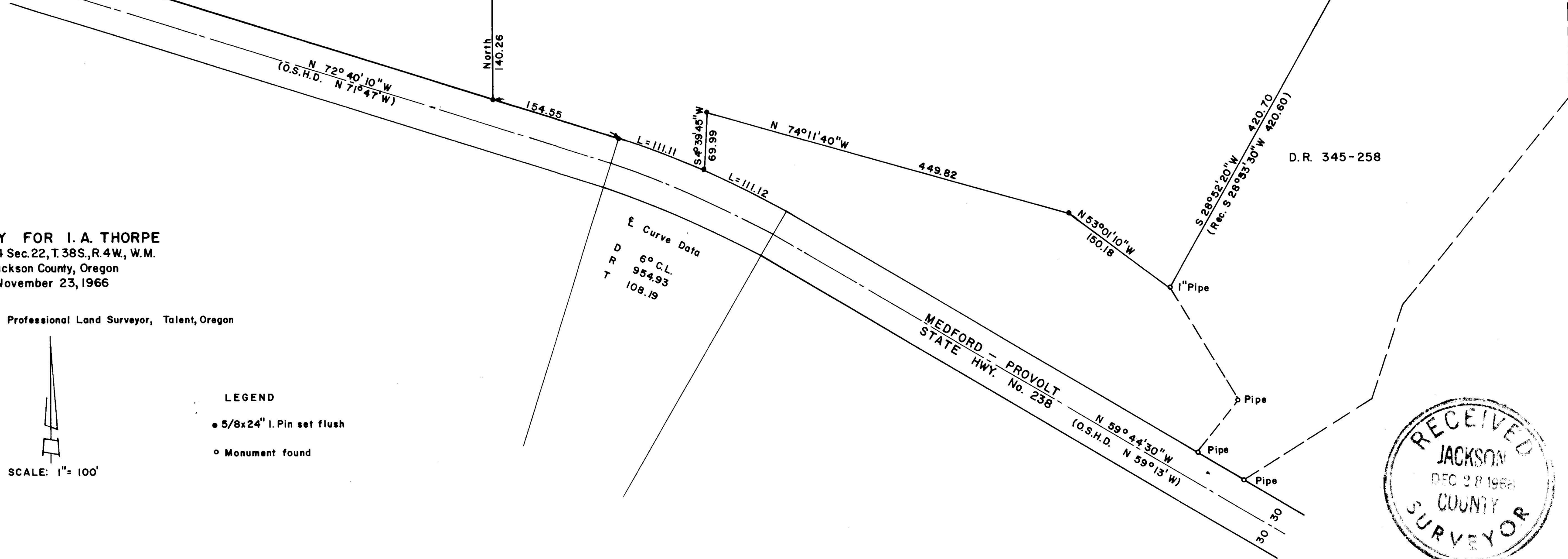

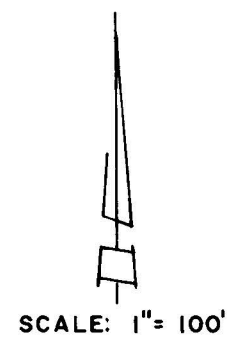

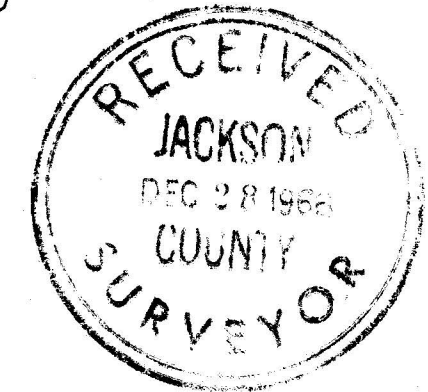

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a parcel for expansion of the Applegate School facilities, as directed by client.

PROCEDURE: Recovered monuments set in Recorded Survey No. 313, as indicated on the accompanying Plat. Traversed from the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Iron Pin on the North line of D.L.C. 38, to the Int. Ell Cor., said D.L.C. 38, and set pin on line as shown. Highway center-line established from Survey No. 313. Curve and westerly tangent produced along center of the highway as presently constructed.
