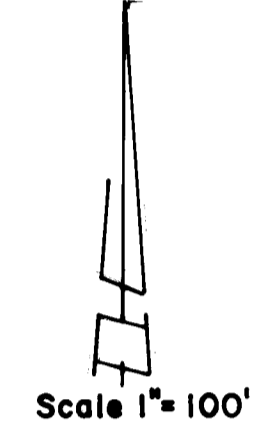

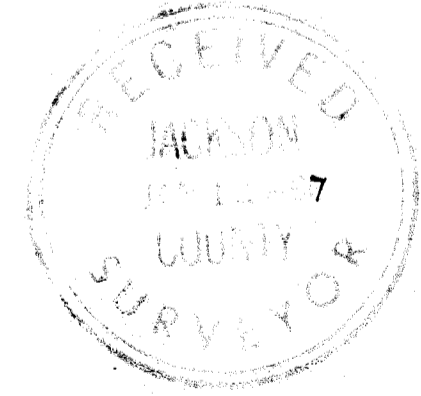

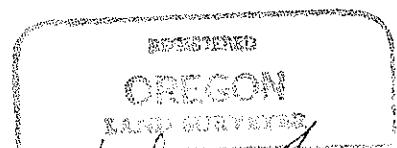
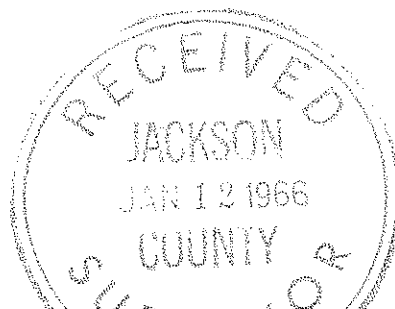
SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: Raymond Elbert
1802 Orchard Home Drive
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To survey and monument various parcels in the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28,
T. 35 S., R. 2 W., as directed by client.

PROCEDURE: Traversed between the four One Quarter corners of said Section 28
to determine the location of the Center One Quarter corner. Set
Center One Quarter corner, and 1/16th corner as shown on the Inset
Plat.

The center-line of Webber Road determined from recovered angle-point
spikes, as set by the office of the County Engineer. Said County
Engineer designed appropriate curves from Topog. survey performed
by this office, and said curves were monumented accordingly. Parcel
corners set as indicated on the accompanying Plat.
